In producing herewith 02 (two) arrested accused persons namely (i) Bablu Sk (28) S/O Manjur Hossain of Vill. Sahabazpur Babultola, PS Kaliachak, Malda and (ii) Nasir Sk (30) s/o Jomidar Sk of Darjitola, PO Golapganj, PS Kaliachak, Malda along with seized articles as mentioned below:-

1. One (01) transparent plastic packet wrapped with transparent celotape containing brownish colored powder believed to be brown sugar weighing 106 grams marked as "Exhibit A".
2. One (01) transparent plastic packet wrapped with transparent celotape containing brownish colored powder believed to be brown sugar weighing 103 grams marked as "Exhibit B".
Total weight - 209 grams of brownish colored powder believed to be brown sugar.
3. One (01) ivory white OPPO android mobile handset having IMEI No. 866595072886270 & 866595072886262 fitted with one JIO SIM card having ICCID No. 89918400400626262294 seized from the accused Nasir Sk. having mobile no. 8670280924.
4. One (01) off white colored Lava android mobile handset Model - LZ404 having IMEI No. 354331671507631 & 354331671507649 inserted with 02 JIO SIM card having ICCID No. 89918400400717038678 & 89918400400629503165 seized from the accused Bablu Sk.
5. One (01) copy of Adhar Card having Adhar No. 555583156621 in the name of Nasir Sk.
6. One (01) copy of Adhar Card having Adhar No. 381896236264 in the name of Bablu Sk.
7. One (01) Black with Maroon stripes Colored school bag (Back Pack) styled as "HP" seized from Bablu Sk. containing contraband mentioned in Sl. No. (i).
8. One (01) Maroon colored hand bag styled as "LIBYA-4, S.K. SAKIB" seized from Nasir Sk. containing contraband mentioned in Sl. No. (ii).
9. Indian currency Rs. 1400/- (Rupees One thousand four hundred only).

I, SI Avishek Lama of STF, WB, Siliguri do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that today on 18.07.2024 at about 16:05 hrs, I received an information from my credible source that two persons, namely Bablu and Nasir of Malda, are illegally carrying with them a huge quantity of heroin, a controlled substance under the NDPS Act. They are expected to cross through, Bhanumati Road, near Kashmir Colony More area under NJP P.S

This information suggests a strong likelihood of a cognizable offense under the NDPS Act being committed. If not acted immediately they would succeed to smuggle the same



I reduced the information in writing vide STF, WB, Siliguri PS GDE No. 245, dated 18.07.2025 and I intimated the information to Shri Praveen Pradhan, Inspector of Police, STF, WB, Siliguri Unit, who brought the information to the superior authority of STF, WB headquarter and after obtaining necessary order at about 17:10 hrs myself, along with a team consisting of i. Myself, ii. SI Rickey Tamang, iii. SI Shambik Majumder, iv, SI Sangay Lama Tamang v. ASI Shouvkur Kundu vi C/61 Raghunth Roy Aswar and vii. C/60 Pradip Roy took departure from STF WB, Siliguri for Bhanumati Road, near Kashmir Colony More area under NJP P.S along with laptop, portable printer, weighing machine, Drug Testing Kits and other necessary documents articles required for operation availing Govt. vehicle WB 94G/6060 & WB16BC261 to work out the information and the same was diarized vide STF, WB, Siliguri P.S GDE No. 248, dated 18.07.2025 and MCC No. 17/2025 dated: 18.07.2025.

At about 18:10, myself and raid team reached at Bhanumati Road, near Kashmir Colony More area under NJP P.S, and met my source and he briefed me about the detail information. I then looked for public witnesses and found 02 persons namely:

i. Birendra Paswan (32) S/O Lt. Yogendra Paswan of 215 A, Ward No. 32, PS NJP, Dist. Jalpaiguri -734007 and ii. Manav Pramanik (27) S/O Haripada Pramanik of Jorapakri, Binnaguri, PS NJP, Dist. Jalpaiguri 735135 and briefed them the information in hand in a nutshell after listening to the information they both voluntarily agreed to stand as witness for the entire process of search and seizure. Thereafter, we ambushed at Bhanumati Road under NJP PS.

At about 16:25 hrs, we saw two persons approaching towards us at Bhanumati Road, near Kashmir Colony More area under NJP P.S from Tinbatti more side. My source identified the two persons as our suspects accordingly we detained them. We then cordoned them and I introduced myself and the raid team members as Police personal showing our Govt. ID proofs, I then appraised them about the information in hand and started to examine them one by one. During examination, they stated their names as (i) Bablu Sk (28) S/O Manjur Hossain of Vill. Sahabazpur Babultola, PS Kaliachak, Malda and (ii) Nasir Sk (30) s/o Jomidar Sk of Darjitola, P.O Golapganj, P.S Kaliachak, Malda. I asked them if they had any ID proof they stated that they had photo copies of their Aadhar Card with them. On further questioning, the above noted 02 detainees made contradictory statements at different times but finally they confessed that they were in conscious possession of huge quantities of Heroin which were packed in sealed plastic packets concealed inside their bags which they were carrying. I then immediately as per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) I explained the above noted 02 detainees and the same was given to them separately in writing stating that they have legal right to tender their personal search in front
