Subject: FIR.

Sir,

In producing herewith the arrested person namely Deepraj Singh (28years) S/O Lt Acchalal Singh of Upper Bhanu nagar, PO Sevoke road, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri, along with the seized articles.

- 1) One-shutter improvised fire arms fitted with Trigger, Hammer, Firing Pin and Butt (wooden) measuring approx 10 inch (Barrel to Butt) marked as exhibit A.
- 2) One live Cartridge marked as exhibit B.

I, Sub-Inspector Youel Lepcha, son of Jai Tshering Lepcha, of Bhaktinagar Police Station, would like to report that on July 25, 2025, at approximately 00:30 hours, during my mobile patrol duty (as recorded in Bhaktinagar Police Station General Diary Entry No. 1600/25 dated July 25, 2025), I received information from a credible source. This source indicated that a person, approximately 28 or 29 years of age, was moving suspiciously with an armed individual on Sevoke Road, in front of the City Plaza building, under the jurisdiction of Bhaktinagar Police Station. The information suggested he was planning to commit a crime in a nearby area. Upon receiving this information, I reported it to you and the duty officer. Following your instructions, I, along with Sub-Inspector Srimanta Chatterjee, Assistant Sub-Inspector Dipak Karmakar, Assistant Sub-Inspector Khagen Barman, and Constable 374 Debraj Biswas, proceeded to the location in a government vehicle.

At around 00:45 hours, we arrived sevoke road, where I met with my source, who confirmed the information once again. We then proceeded to the specified location. On our way, I enlisted the help of two passers-by as witnesses, who were informed of our purpose and willingly agreed to assist us. Their details are as follows namely 1) Md Kalim (33 years) S/O Lt Md Muhamud Uddin of Pareash nagar, near Agni sikha club, ward no 44, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri. (owner of Calcutta Arsenal Biryani house located in sevoke road) and 2) Suman Mondal (44 years) S/O Lt Mantu Mondal of Pradhan more Ektiasal ward no 40, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri (Staff of Md Kalim). As we approached the area, we noticed an individual attempting to flee, but we managed to apprehend him. Upon questioning, he identified himself as Deepraj Singh, 28 years old, son of the late Acchalal Singh, residing in Upper Bhanu Nagar, PO Sevoke Road, Bhaktinagar Police Station, Jalpaiguri District. After apprehending him, we disclosed our identities and the reason for his detention. He confirmed his name and address as noted above and further admitted that he was present in the area with firearms loaded with ammunition, intending to commit a crime.

Initially, I requested him to search our police team, which he refused. Subsequently, I conducted a search of him in the presence of the witnesses. During the search, I recovered the aforementioned items from his waist. When asked, he was unable to provide any valid documents or proof concerning the firearms. Therefore, I seized and labeled the items in accordance with proper procedures, prepared a seizure list in the presence of the witnesses, and obtained their signatures. A copy of the seizure list was provided to the apprehended individual between 01:25 hours and 02:05 hours. The entire seizure process was conducted with audio-video recording, and I arrested him under Section 35 of the BNSS.

In light of the facts and circumstances mentioned above, I respectfully request that a specific case be initiated against Deepraj Singh, aged 28, son of the late Acchalal Singh, residing in Upper Bhanu Nagar, PO Sevoke Road, PS Bhaktinagar, Dist Jalpaiguri. I also kindly ask that an investigation be arranged into this matter.
