Sir,

With due respect I, SI. Jimut Kanti Roy of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do here by lodge this written complaint against three unknown accused persons.

In this regard, I beg to report that on 12.07.2025, I was endorsed a Memo No 1693/ACP, East-II SPC Dt. 09.07.25 to enquire into the matter for taking necessary action as per law. In course of enquiry of the Memo, I contacted one Murtaba Alamun of Alingur GP (Near Mosque) Block- Kaliachak -I, Sub-Division- Malda Sadar, Police Station, Kaliachak, Malda Police District, Phone No: 9851517674 and on enquiry I learnt from him that he is a Truck Driver by profession. He stated that, on 10.06.25 at around 12 am while he was transporting bamboo in a 14 wheeler truck through Siliguri Fullbari Toll Tax area, which falls under NJP police station, some unknown police personnel stopped his vehicle and demanded Rs. 10,000 without any valid reason. He was told that if he refused to pay, a case would be filed against him and his vehicle would not be allowed to proceed. He also mentioned that he was threatened and harassed in this area, near landmark Toll Tax. When he requested the officer to reduce the amount, the officer agreed to take RS.1900 instead. After paying this amount, he was allowed to continue with his truck. He also clarified that the person who stopped him and took the money was not traffic or civic police officer but a regular police officer. However he did not know the officers name or designation. On enquiry, he further reported that there were two persons in police uniform and one in civil. The truck driver was carrying long bamboos in his track, to carry those bamboos he had to open the rear DALA of his truck and those bamboos were extended and suspended beyond the limit of the truck. The Truck driver also stated that he had been given one Mobile phone number i.e. 9719513359 number by one of those three and asked him to make contact with that Mobile-phone owner before coming next time that person also told him to inform him early and in lieu of Rs. 1200/- and when there was no police van and his vehicle would pass with his illegal carriage. This refers to NJP Ps GDE No. 1215/25 Dt 24.07.25.

Under the above circumstances, Therefore, I pray before you that a specific case may kindly be initiated against three unknown miscreants under appropriate sections of law and arrange for its investigation.
