Sir,

I, ASI Manoj Majumdar of NJP PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person namely Sakil Paswan (48/M) s/o Rajendra Paswan of Paschimi Siso, PS- Kabirchak, Dist. Darbanga Bihar under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. 06 bottle of Himalayan Gold Indian Made Liquar 60 up each bottle containing 600 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A.
2. 05 bottles 70 up Himalayan Fatafati Indian Made Liquar each bottle containing 300 ml Marked as Exhibit-B.

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today 25.07.2025 at 17.55 hrs. I received source information that one person was carrying and selling Liquor illegally at DS Colony under NJP PS to its customers without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and I.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself along with ASI Nilam Swarnakar, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, VP- 13 Jamirul Islam, VP- 08 Laxman Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for South Colony to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS GDE No. 1310 Dated- 25.07.2025. On arrival at the spot on 25.07.2025 at 18.25 hrs. it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally from DS Colony to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seen the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above and also confessed that he is selling Id Liquor illegally to his designated customers without any license. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I recovered the above noted articles from his possession and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 35 BNSS as It's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made on 25.07.25 in between 19.05 hrs to 19.25 hrs. (Total 5.1 ltrs).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against one arrested person namely Sakil Paswan (48/M) s/o Rajendra Paswan of Paschimi Siso, PS- Kabirchak, Dist. Darbanga Bihar and arrange for its investigation.


