With due respect, I **Sri. Subrata Chowdhury**, Son of Late Santosh Kumar Chowdhury, resident of Haripur, Shudangi Hat, Dabgram(P), P.O. Sahudangir Hat, P.S. New Jalpaiguri Dist. Jalpaiguri, W.B.- 735135 beg to state that with the intention to purchase one wine shop license, I was searching for any lawful owner of wine shop who is intending to sell his wine shop license and at the relevant time one person namely **SRI. DEBAJIT DUTTA**, Son of Late Debashish Dutta, resident of N.J.P. Gate Bazar, Opposite Gali of "Jayram Pharmacy", P.O. Siliguri Bazar, P.S. New Jalpaiguri, Dist. Jalpaiguri, W.B.- 734007, M- 6294852711/6297141073 have come to my residence and he has introduced himself as a broker and he has taken a sum of Rs.1,00,000/- from me for the purpose to make the advance payment to the lawful owner of wine shop. He had induced me to pay such amount and promised me that he will pay such amount to the owner of wine shop license holder. Subsequently said Debajit Dutta has failed to crack the deal with the wine shop owner and when I have asked him to return back the aforesaid amount, he has has issued an A/C. payee Cheque being No. 126059 dated 06/03/2025 amounting of Rs.60,000/- drawn on Bank of India, New Jalpaiguri Branch, Dist. Jalpaiguri in my favour but when I have presented the said cheque the said cheque was bounced/ dishonoured due to "Funds Insufficient" on 13/03/2025(I have initiated a case under provision of Negotiable Instruments Act against such dishonour of cheque before the Ld. Court for the amount of Rs.60,000/-). Although a further amount of **Rs.40,000/-** is also payable by said Debajit Dutta. From the very beginning said Debajit Dutta has dishonest intention to cheat me and he had also given false assurances to me that he will definitely return the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- to me. Thereafter on several occasions lastly on 29.04.2025, I have requested and asked said Debajit Dutta, but till date he has not paid me any of the amount and only giving false assurances.

Therefore, I request you to take necessary legal action against said **DEBAJIT DUTTA**, Son of Late Debashish Dutta, resident of N.J.P. Gate Bazar, Opposite Gali of "Jayram Pharmacy", P.O. Siliguri Bazar, P.S. New Jalpaiguri, Dist. Jalpaiguri, W.B.- 734007, M- 6294852711/6297141073 for punishing him as per provision of law. And for this kindness, I shall much oblige to you.
