Subject: FIR regarding Domestic Violence, Financial Exploitation, and Harassment against my son, daughter-in-law, and her parents.

Complaint by: Arati Sharma, wife of late Hari Sharma, residing at Himachal Colony, Mallaguri. including Quarter No 276. Siliguri.

Sir.

I am Arati Sharma, the wife of late Hari Sharma. My son, Anmol Sharma, received a job on compassionate grounds after my husband's demise on January 23, 2023. He is currently employed at Thindharia Workshop, opposite Tindharia Hospital.

My son, Anmol Sharma, married Sneha Chettri in 2023. After my husband's death, I received Rs. 6 lakhs as financial benefits. From this amount, I gave Rs. 2 lakhs to my son, Rs. 1 lakh to my daughter-in-law, Sneha Sharma, and used the remaining amount to construct a tin house within the same premises as their quarter, with their full knowledge and consent.

However, recently, my son Anmol Sharma, his wife Sneha Sharma, and her parents Narayan and Sanjila Chettri have taken complete control of my finances. They have seized my passbook, ATM card, and bank account details, effectively denying me access to my own pension amount, to which I am legally entitled.

In addition to financial exploitation, I have been subjected to severe verbal and physical abuse on multiple occasions. They have repeatedly assaulted me. A specific incident occurred when I visited my sister-in-law's house in Darjeeling in 2024. My daughter-in-law, Sneha Sharma, along with her entire family, arrived there and physically assaulted me with her sandals, verbally abusing me with derogatory names in front of others.

Despite these atrocities, I continued to live with them for the sake of my son, but the situation has only deteriorated. They treat me like a domestic slave, forcing me to perform household chores without proper care or respect. My son's father-in-law Mr. Narayan Chettri frequently consumes alcohol and, on a recent occasion, he publicly defamed my character in front of the entire family, merely because I attempted to contact my sisters.

Furthermore, my son, Anmol Sharma, along with his in-laws, have taken possession of all my crucial legal documents, including those related to my land and my flat, "MB Fortune," located in Medical, Kadamtala, Durgamandir, left under my name by my late husband. I do not have access to any of my personal or property documents.

I am in constant fear for my safety from every member of that family. My daughter-in-law's parents continue to beat me, use abusive language, and treat me as a slave. There have been multiple instances where they have locked me inside the house when they leave, confining me against my will.

I, therefore, request you to kindly register this First Information Report (FIR) under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code and the Domestic Violence Act, and take immediate necessary legal action against my son Anmol Sharma, his wife Sneha Sharma, and her parents, Mr. Narayan Chettri and Mrs. Sanjila Chettri.
