Subject: Complaint against auto driver Sanjeev Ray for violent assault causing permanent loss of vision

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Rupam Puri, am writing this complaint on behalf of Mr. Biswanath Adhikari, a resident of Ashram Para, Muzaffar Ahmed Sarani, Siliguri, regarding a violent and deliberate physical assault by one Sanjeev Ray, a fellow auto driver.

On 26th July 2025 (Saturday), a dispute occurred concerning the number-based turn system followed at the Sevoke More auto stand. Mr. Adhikari had momentarily left the stand for personal reasons, but his position in the queue remained valid. Upon returning, he clarified his number and resumed work accordingly. However, Sanjeev Ray, feeling resentful, issued threats stating, "Come tomorrow, I will beat your eyes and face."

On the morning of 27th July 2025 (Sunday), Mr. Adhikari arrived at the auto stand for work. While he was standing next to his vehicle, Sanjeev Ray approached him aggressively, used offensive language, and suddenly punched him directly in both eyes. Around approximately 10:00 Am, As a result, Mr. Adhikari suffered permanent blindness in his right eye and serious damage to the left eye. The trauma was so severe that the right eyeball became soft and completely destroyed.

He was immediately taken to Disha Eye Hospital, where doctors declared the injury too critical for their facility. They referred him to North Bengal Medical College for specialized treatment. Before reaching there, several other hospitals also stated they could not provide the necessary care. Mr. Adhikari is now under treatment at North Bengal Medical College.

This complaint is being written and submitted by me, Rupam Puri, on behalf of Mr. Biswanath Adhikari, and has been acknowledged and accepted as true by his wife, Mrs. Jharna Adhikari. I earnestly request that strict and appropriate legal action be initiated against Sanjeev Ray at the earliest.
