Sir,

I Dalti Dori, wife of Kusheswar Mahato
resident of Ishon road, Durganagar, Ward no-40 of
S.M.E. P.O - Senoke road, P.S. Bhaktinagar,
District - Jalpaiguri, do hereby lodge this
FIR on the following facts:-

That, Today i.e., on 04/08/2025 between 8.30
to 9 pm. While I was busy with household
work, I suddenly heard a... alarmingly and
loud sound coming from our main gate. Finding
it suspicious, I immediately rushed outside
and saw that our pet dog was bleeding
from his mouth and one person named
Pradip Paswan who is our neighbour had
thrown a bolder targeting our pet dog in the
intention to kill it.

When my nephew Dinesh Mahato questioned
him about this act, Pradip Paswan became
aggressive and abused him with filthy language
that is unrepeatable in a civilized society. When
I requested him to not to harm our pet dog
as it had not disturbed anyone, he began

abusing in a similar filthy and obscene language, then held the place threatening that they will kill us if we dare to stay there for the next 20 minutes.

Shortly afterwards the said Pradip Mahato Paswan returned with his brother Santoh Paswan and his father Shankar Paswan. along with more than 20 other antisocial elements and miscreants. Two of them was Pawan Mahato and Sandip Sharma. They were armed with sharp weapons. (Showers), knives, wooden baton, iron rods. They forcefully entered into our house and dragged my nephew, Rishi Mahato outside. They then brutally attacked him on head and forehead with the clear intention to kill him, as he bled profusely and tried to run and escape, one of the accused Pradip Paswan threw a shower targeting his head. it struck in the back of his head causing a deep injury and he fell unconscious on the ground.

When I rushed to rescue my nephew, the accused persons assaulted me physically. they outraged my modesty by forcefully touching my chest and abused me physically. They also snatched my gold mangalsutra. as I screamed for help our neighbors came out of their homes and intervened, managing to rescue us. The accused

and their associates fled the scene while threatening us with severe consequences and death. We are now living in constant fear for our lives and Rishal Mahato is admitted in hospital fighting with the fear of death.

I, therefore humbly request you to take necessary legal action against the abovementioned persons to protect our lives and rights, and ensure that Justice is served.
