Subject: Complaint against my husband and his relatives for subjecting me  
to cruelty and threats to life.

Respected Madam/Sir,

I, Jyoti Pradhan, W/O Mohan Thapa, presently residing at Salugara, Kalchakra Gumba road, Near Chi Chi Clothing store, Siliguri, West Bengal, respectfully submit this complaint against my husband Mohan Thapa and his family members for subjecting me to continuous acts of cruelty mental, emotional, physical, and psychological, ever since my marriage.

I was married to Mohan Thapa on 11.02.1997 in accordance with personal laws and social customs. However, over time, my matrimonial life turned into a constant source of physical and mental torture due to the abusive and cruel conduct of my husband and his family members. On several occasions, he assaulted me. One particularly brutal incident in 2019 involved him threatening me and our son with a "Khukuri" (a curved knife) in a drunken rage, as a result, I was compelled to leave the matrimonial home and I am presently residing separately with my son at rental house at Salugara, Kalchakra Gumba road, Near Chi Chi Clothing store, Siliguri.



In another grave incident in 2019, during a violent altercation, he kicked me forcefully on my chest, which resulted in temporary paralysis for several months. I was under medical care and trauma during this period.

That approximately two months prior to the filing of this complaint, my husband, accompanied by his two brothers, namely Raju Thapa and Kiran Thapa, came to my current place of stay without any lawful justification. My husband was armed with a stick, and he, along with his brothers, threatened me with dire consequences. He used filthy, abusive, and vulgar language against me and also verbally insulted and humiliated my late mother in the most degrading and offensive manner. Their conduct was not only deeply disrespectful but also a serious affront to my dignity and mental well-being.

That my husband's conduct during the said incident was aggressive, intimidating, and violent in nature. His presence with a weapon, combined with the use of threats and abusive language, caused me severe psychological trauma and fear for my life and safety. The entire episode occurred in a public setting, exposing me to social humiliation and emotional distress.

That again, on 4<sup>th</sup> of August 2025 before the filing of this complaint, my husband deliberately approached me near my aunt's residence at Momo Shop in Shastri Nagar. On this occasion too, he was abusive and aggressive against me and my maternal Aunt. In a threatening tone, he stated that "even if I initiate any legal proceedings, I will receive nothing and will be

deprived of all rights." This statement was clearly intended to intimidate me and obstruct me from seeking justice or asserting my lawful entitlements.

That during this second incident, one of my friends named Agam Gurung was present with me and witnessed the entire incident. She can testify to the abusive and threatening behaviour displayed by my husband.

That I am now living under a constant sense of fear and insecurity. My husband's repeated acts of criminal intimidation, use of offensive and obscene language, threats to my life, and continued harassment amount to serious criminal offences.

Therefore, I humbly request your good office to kindly register my complaint as an FIR; Initiate a thorough investigation into the matter ensure immediate protection to me and my family members Take necessary legal action against my husband Mohan Thapa and his brothers to ensure that such unlawful conduct is not repeated.

I am ready and willing to provide any further details or documents and cooperate fully with the police during the investigation.
