Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested lady accused person namely Ujjwala Saha (60 yrs) w/o Lt. Bimal Saha of Hatiadanaga near Hanuman Mandir, PO- Sahudangihat, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri along with the following articles under proper seizure list: -

[1] 12 (Twelve) sealed bottles of "HIMALAYAN GOLD 60 UP PET India Made Liquor each bottle containing 600 ml, i.e.  $600 \times 12 = 7200$  ml, having M.R.P. of Rs. 160/- i.e.  $160 \times 12 = 1920$ /-, blended and bottled by Himalayan Endeavour Pvt. Ltd and is marked as "Exhibit-A" out of which 01 (One) bottle taken as a sample and marked as "Exhibit -A-1".

I, ASI Tapan Roy s/o Fanindranath Roy of Ashighar OP under Bhaktinagar Police Station Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above-noted arrested lady accused person, namely Ujjwala Saha, to the effect that today on 12/08/2025 at 15:25 hours, I received information from a reliable source indicating that a woman was storing and selling illicit liquor at her residence in Hatiadanda, near Hanuman Mandir, under Bhaktinagar Police Station, Dist. Jalpaiguri, without any valid license. This information was documented in the General Diary of Ashighar OP GDE No. 378 dated 12/08/2025, and I shared it with the Officer-in-Charge of Ashighar OP. Following his instructions, I, along with a team that included female officers, proceeded to Hatiadanga to verify the authenticity of the information. We reached there at about 15:55 hrs, and as identified by the source, we held a raid at the house of Ujjwala Saha and managed to detain her. On being asked, she disclosed her identity as noted above and stated that she has stored the illicit liquor and is selling the same at her house without any valid license for her wrongful gain. On further search, the above-noted seized articles were recovered from her house. On-demand, she failed to produce any valid license/papers for selling and storing such articles. On further interrogation, she stated that she had been involved in storing and selling illicit liquor without any valid license for the last few months for her illegal gain. Then, I seized and labelled the above-mentioned liquor under the proper seizure list and arrested the lady accused person mentioned above, named Ujjwala Saha, after observing all sorts of formalities at the spot. The whole process of seizure and labelling has been made between 16:05 hrs. and 16:14 hrs. under proper videography.

Under the above-noted fact and circumstances, I, therefore, pray before your good self that a specific case may kindly be initiated against the arrested accused person Ujjwala Saha (60 yrs) w/o Lt. Bimal Saha of Hatiadanaga near Hanuman Mandir, PO- Sahudangihat, PS- Bhaktinagar, Dist- Jalpaiguri under proper section of law and may arrange to cause its investigation for violation of rules and norms of Bengal Excise Act.
