**Subject: Complaint for frequent threats received in connection with NJP  
PS Case No. 148/25 and Writ Petition No. WPA/1522/25.**

Respected Sir,

I, Suman Palit, son of the late Sudhangshu Palit, residing at Jail Khana Road, Bagracoat, Siliguri, wish to lodge a formal complaint regarding the frequent threats I have been receiving from the accused and their associates. These threats are aimed at forcing me to withdraw a case related to my now deceased younger brother, Sibam Palit.

**The details of the matter are as follows:-**

I have filed a case against my now deceased younger brother's wife and in-laws regarding his murder, which is currently pending before the Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate (CJM), Jalpaiguri, vide NJP PS Case No. 148/25. Additionally, a writ petition, WPA/1522/25, is pending before the Honorable High Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri, regarding police inaction in the said case in the form of Mandamus.

In effect of the writ petition, one of the five accused, Priya Pramanik @ Puja, who is the wife of my now deceased younger brother, was arrested and is currently in judicial custody. On the day of her arrest, I was at the High Court. Upon receiving the news of her arrest during proceedings of Writ Petition, my mother, our advocate, and I proceeded to the District Court at Jalpaiguri for the case proceedings. There, we saw Priya Pramanik was brought by the Police for produced before the court. Upon seeing us, she

threatened our advocate in the presence of my mother and me, stating, "For you, I'm going to jail, I will see you."

The threats have escalated since then. A few days later, while I was returning home from Sevoke Road, some miscreants stopped me in front of the Bagracoat bus stand and threatened me to withdraw the case.

On Sunday, August 10, 2025, at approximately 10:30 PM, my mother and I were returning home from our advocate's house in preparation for a hearing of our writ petition scheduled for the next day, August 11, 2025. On the way around the Baghajatin Park area, 4-5 miscreants stopped us and threatened me not to attend the High Court proceedings the next day, stating that if I did, they would "send me to my now deceased brother." They also menaced my mother, telling her to "control me and not to fight for any justice," otherwise they would "treat me as they have treated my younger brother," referring to him as "semi-chopped." We managed to escape and immediately informed our advocate.

Our advocate attempted to contact the Inspector-in-Charge of NJP Police Station instantly, but the call was disconnected. The next day, our advocate personally brought us to the Calcutta High Court, where she described the entire matter to the Second Officer of the NJP Police Station over a telephonic conversation that frequent threats we were receiving from the accused's associates, who are still at large. Unfortunately, we have not received any fruitful results from this communication till yet. Due to my regular attendance at the Honorable High Court for case proceedings, I was unable to lodge this complaint earlier.
