I, NAWIN XALXO, S/O CHETAN LAL XALXO,
R/O Punai Busty, Dakshin Bagdogra, P.O. + P.S. Bagdogra,
Dist - Darjeeling, W.B., 734014 would like to inform you
that on 13th July 2025, around 08:00 pm, that I was returning
home on my motorcycle bearing registration WB 74 BD 9784
(Bajaj Dominar, Color - Black) on Bhuyiapani Asian Highway 2,
one speeding motorcycle without headlights hit me they came
out of nowhere probably coming from wrong side, I was
in complete shock and had sustained major injuries, fortunately
a Patrolling Police Van was close by who witnessed the accident
and rushed for my aid, the persons who were responsible for
the accident had fled the scene leaving behind their motor
vehicle, I was immediately admitted to nearby Bagdogra
Primary Health Care Centre from then I was taken immediately
to (Galaxy Hospital, Upper Bagdogra) from there I was shifted
to Bishop James Memorial Rural Health Care Centre, Uttar Kumar
Para, Mohitnagar, Dist - Jalpaiguri, I had major injuries where
my whole flesh on my right leg came off, I also sustained
multiple injuries on both my hands (Medical Documents Attached),
if it was not for Police Patrolling Van I would have been left
for dead.
