Respected Sir,

I, the undersigned would like to inform you that in the year of 2005, I was in search of a suitable piece of land situated within Bagdogra area of Siliguri Sub-division and finally I came across one Rajkishore Choudhary, son of Late Medhu Choudhary, resident of village - Gowala Busty, Bhujia Pani who due to his financial distress was not in a position to look after his landed property measuring about 5 kathas situated within Mouza-Bhujiapani, Police Station - Bagdogra, recorded in Plot No. 187, 188, 192 and 193, J.L. No. 98, Touzi No. 91 under Siliguri Sub-Division and hence offered me to transfer the possession of his said land forever against the consideration of a sum amounting Rs. 36,250/ (Rupees Thirty Six Thousand Two Hundred Fifty) only.
