

Sir,

In producing herewith five (05) accused persons namely (i) Raja Sarkar (23 yrs) S/O Late Nikhil Sarkar of Samar Nagar, near Sathi Sangha Club, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist.- Darjeeling (ii) Md Mumtaj (27 yrs) S/O Late Md Mafij of Gandhi Nagar, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri (iii) Mithun Singh (26 yrs) S/O Jogindar Singh of Ratanlal Busty, Ward No-45, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling (iv) Rahul Singh (22 yrs) S/O Binod Singh of Bhanu Nagar, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri and (v) Sonam Sherpa (25 yrs) S/O Late Lakpa Sherpa of Vusuk 7 th mile, PS- Gangtok, Dist. East Sikkim under arrest along with the following seizure articles viz :- (i) One iron made weapon locally called as "DEGAR" measuring 17 inches in length including its wooden Butt, (ii) One sharp cutting weapon locally called as "HASUA" measuring approx 25 inches in length including its wooden butt, (iii) One iron made rod locally called as "SABOL" measuring 24 inches in length, (iv) One iron made instruments called as PLUS (v) One iron made hummer measuring 13 inches in length including its iron handle, and (vi) One multi colour nynon bag. I, ASI Bikash Roy of Pradhan Nagar PS, SPC do hereby lodge this written complaint against the above noted five (05) arrested accused persons and others 06/07 unknown miscreants who involve in this crime, to the effect that on 28.08.2025 at 22.15 hrs I received a specific source information that about 11/12 miscreants equipped deadly weapons assembled in an abandand railway quarter at BRI Colony under PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling and they are making preparations for committing Dacoity at BRI Colony and its surrounding area. Accordingly, I diarized the fact in P.S. General diary vide Pradhan Nagar PS GDE No. 1746 dated 28.08.2025 and informed the matter to you. As per your kind order and direction, I along with SI Bandhan Roy, ASI Prabal Sarkar, ASI Biplab Kr Das and force all of Pradhan Nagar PS, SPC left for BRI Colony under PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist.- Darjeeling by Govt. vehicle with investigation kits to verify the veracity of the information without any search warrant or authorization for search which could not be possible to obtain from a competent authority for sudden development of a sensitive information and not to afford them opportunity for concealment of evidence or facility for their escape. I also informed night van officer ASI Anwar Abedin of Pradhan Nagar PS and requested him to come to BRI Colony to accompany us. After arrival at BRI Colony Then, I requested two available independent witnesses namely (i) Arun Sahani (25 yrs) S/O Upendar Sahani of Rejendra Nagar, Coolipara, Ward No-01, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling and (ii) Raja Sahani (26 yrs), S/O Chunchun Sahani of Reajendra Nagar, Coolipara, Ward No. 01, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling and shared the information with them and requested them to remain present and act as witness if any search and seizure would be made, upon which they agreed. In the mean time night RT van officer ASI Anwar Abedin along with is RT van force arrived at the spot and accompanied with us. I shared the information with them and briefed them properly. Then, I contacted my source and from a considerable distance he pointed to the place where the miscreants were assembled.

Thereafter, we proceeded towards the place being identified by the source and cordoned the place from every corner with due care and caution and from a considerable distance. We noticed that 11/12 perspms were assembled at an abandoned railway quater, situated at BRI Colony under PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling and they were whispering in a low voice. On seeing police personnel approaching towards them they tried to flee away from the spot but on hot chase we managed to apprehended above noted five (05) accused persons while 06/07 others unknown miscreants managed to flee away through others exit points, taking the advantage of darkness.

Received on 28/08/25 at 23:45 hrs vide Pradhan Nagar PS GDE No 1755 and started Pradhan Nagar PS case NO 594/25 Dtd. 28/08/25 D/S 310(A) (5) of GNS and endorsed to SI Rajiv Dubba for its investigation.

Thereafter, we disclosed our identities as Police personnel (as we were in civil dress for our convenience). On interrogation, they disclosed their identities as noted above. On search recovered the above noted weapon of offence from their joint possession which they kept concealed inside one multi color nylon bag.

On further interrogation, they furnished incoherent statements and failed to give any satisfactory reply for their presence with deadly weapons in such deaf hour of night. Finally they disclosed that they along with 06/07 of their associates assembled there and were making preparations for committing Dacoity at BRI Colony and its surrounding area. Accordingly, I seized the above mentioned weapons of offence from their joint possessions under proper seizure list in between **22.55 hrs to 23.30 hrs** at the spot in presence of witnesses and duly signed by the witnesses and acknowledged by the accused persons and subsequently arrested them under proper memo of arrest and observing all the formalities of arrest. They are informed on the ground of their arrest. The whole process of search and seizure were made under the coverage of videography as per norms of BNSS and brought all the five (05) arrested accused persons along with seized articles to Pradhan Nagar Police Station for further investigation. From the above noted facts and seizure of incriminating articles there is strong reason to believe that all the above noted five (05) accused persons along with 06/07 of their associates who fled away, gathered there equipped with deadly weapons at such deaf hour of night and taking preparation to commit Dacoity in a nearby affluent area at BRI Colony.

Under the above circumstances, I pray before you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly be started against the above noted five (05) arrested accused persons namely i) Raja Sarkar (23 yrs) S/O Late Nikhil Sarkar of Samar Nagar, near Sathi Sangha Club, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist.- Darjeeling (ii) Md Mumtaj (27 yrs) S/O Late Md Mafij of Gandhi Nagar, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri (iii) Mithun Singh (26 yrs) S/O Jogindar Singh of Ratanlal Busty, Ward No-45, PS- Pradhan Nagar, Dist. Darjeeling (iv) Rahul Singh (22 yrs) S/O Binod Singh of Bhanu Nagar, PS- Bhakti Nagar, Dist. Jalpaiguri and (v) Sonam Sherpa (25 yrs) S/O Late Lakpa Sherpa of Vusuk 7 th mile, PS- Gangtok, Dist. East Sikkim and others 06/07 unknown miscreants who fled away from the spot and arranged for its investigation.
