Respected Sir,

I am writing to formally file a complaint regarding severe threats and extortion attempts against my family and me. Due to several health issues, I am unable to file this complaint in person and humbly request you to consider this correspondence as my formal submission.

I am Subir Sanyal, an 81-year-old retired Central Government employee residing at Hasl Niwas, 1st Floor, G.S. Dutta Road, Bharatnagar, Siliguri - 734006.

On August 12, 2025, at 11:29 AM, I received threatening communications from an individual identifying himself as Mr. Kiran. His full name and residential details are unknown, but his phone number is +919022696004. Mr. Kiran claims to have been a business partner of my deceased younger son, Mr. Sudipta Sanyal, who passed away on February 20, 2025, in Tezpur, Assam. Mr. Kiran is making unlawful demands, attempting to coerce me into recognizing him as a business partner of my late son, and insisting that I sell my deceased younger son's property and remit the proceeds to him. To my knowledge, my younger son did not possess any property in his name.

Mr. Kiran is falsely associating his demands with my son's death and has issued explicit threats. He claims significant influence and states he could arrange for my arrest in West Bengal by the Assam Police. These threats have caused extreme mental harassment and fear, especially as I live with my 75-year-old wife, and we are both senior citizens with existing severe health issues. Our elder son, who is our only remaining son and lives with his family, is frequently away on work-related travel, which further exacerbates our vulnerability. I have lived my entire life with dignity, with an impeccable service record in the Indian Railways, including a deputation to the Central Bureau of Investigation.

Additionally, we have received information from credible sources indicating the possible involvement of my late son's wife, Mrs. Munmun Paul Sanyal, either instigating or supporting Mr. Kiran's actions. She was solely responsible for all financial matters during their life together in Tezpur, particularly as my son suffered from severe eyesight problems and was undergoing treatment at LV Prasad Eye Institute, Hyderabad. Since his demise, she has not visited us to inquire about our well-being or acknowledge the regular monthly financial support we provided to her after my son's passing.



It is important to reiterate that, to my knowledge, my late son did not possess any movable or immovable property in his name; any assets, if they existed, were managed solely by his wife. They had been residing independently in Tezpur, Assam, for over 14 years, and she had also refused to change her voter registration to our Siliguri address despite repeated requests, indicating a deliberate distancing from our family. We are still mourning his death, and the first-year rituals (shradha/puja) are yet to be performed. During this period of grief, these threats and continuous harassment have severely impacted our physical and emotional well-being.

Given the gravity of this situation, I humbly request your immediate intervention to initiate an investigation. Furthermore, I seek protection for my family and me from any physical or mental harm, and I respectfully ask for proper action to be taken against Mr. Kiran and any other individuals found to be involved in this harassment and extortion. I have attached a copy of my identity proof.

Thank you for your attention and support in this critical matter. I sincerely hope for your swift and decisive intervention to ensure the safety and dignity of my family.

I would like to bring to your attention a formal complaint for your kind information and necessary action. An email detailing this matter was previously sent on August 13, addressed to the Honourable Commissioner, Siliguri Metropolitan Police, with a follow-up email sent on August 31, 2025.

Thank you for your time and consideration of this important matter.
