Subject: Complaint regarding attempted illegal recording of a woman and child, late-night nuisance by tenants of Physics Wallah, criminal intimidation of advocate's family member, negligence of property owner/authorized leaseholder, false accusations against police and advocate, and repeated threats to residents

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, Advocate Sadaf Parveen, resident of Iskcon Mandir Road, Gital Para, Siliguri, am filing this complaint regarding multiple incidents involving tenants of Physics Wallah residing in a privately rented property (not a hostel). I file this FIR both as an aggrieved resident and representative of affected neighbours and the victim woman, whose statements and signatures are enclosed as annexure A.

Note on Age of Offenders:

The alleged tenants claim to be above 16+. Exact ages are unverified. Police are requested to determine ages and apply juvenile law (JJ Act) for confirmed minors and standard criminal provisions for adults accordingly.

➤ **Attempted Illegal Recording (01-03 September 2025)**

Between 01/09/2025 and 03/09/2025, the tenants attempted to secretly record a woman resident while she was tutoring her minor child at home. The mother observed the act, reacted immediately by shouting and closing/thrashing the window. No confirmed recording is established; this was an attempted violation of privacy.

Applicable Laws:

- Voyeurism: Section 354C IPC / Section 77(2) BNS
- Outraging Modesty: Section 354 IPC / Section 79 BNS
- IT Act, 2000 Section 66E – precautionary for potential electronic recording

Mens Rea:

The act was deliberate and intentional, indicating the offenders knowingly attempted to violate privacy.

If, JJ Act Compliance:

- Offenders are minors; identities confidential (Section 74 JJ Act)
- Investigation through Juvenile Police Officers and Juvenile Justice Board only (Sections 10, 27 JJ Act)

➤ **Late-Night Public Nuisance (Night of 03-04 September 2025)**

On 03/09/2025 since 9 PM, tenants created loud disturbances (shouting, howling, inappropriate group behaviour) until police officers arrived (after almost 45 minutes) and it went on till almost ~2:30 AM on 04/09/2025.

Residents confronted them; they responded with foul and abusive language. Residents kept patience, until 12 AM but then immediately called the police.

Applicable Laws:

- Public Nuisance: Section 268 IPC / Section 354 BNS
- Obscene/Abusive Language: Section 294 IPC / Section 356 BNS
- Criminal Intimidation: Section 506 IPC / Section 351 BNS
- Noise Pollution: Noise Pollution Rules 2000, Rule 7
- Silence Zone Rule 3(5)
- Section 15 Environment (Protection) Act, 1986
- West Bengal Police Act, 2009 Section 41(1)(b)

Mens Rea:

The repeated shouting and abusive language despite requests to stop demonstrates deliberate intent to disturb public peace.

If, JJ Act Compliance:

- Minors handled only through Juvenile Police/Board
- Counselling and parental involvement prioritized (Section 83 JJ Act)

➤ **Criminal Intimidation of Advocate's Family Member (05 September 2025, ~1-2 PM)**

On 05/09/2025, around 1-2 PM, two tenants of Physics Wallah verbally threatened my brother, who is my family member, while boarding their PW bus. I (Sadaf Parveen), personally witnessed this act from the terrace of our residence, where I was engaged in routine household work (collecting clothes).

- Two of the students shouted In Hindi: "Tereko toh dekhlega madarchod" ["We'll see you, motherfucker"].
- This act occurred despite police warnings on 04/09/2025, showing blatant audacity and deliberate intent.
- Given this behaviour, the tenants pose a potential threat to other residents, especially women and children, in the neighbourhood.
 - All tenants' identities must be furnished to the residents for safety and security.
 - Authorities should take immediate preventive action, including vacating the premises as soon as possible, ensuring no further threat from current tenants.

Applicable Laws:

- Criminal Intimidation: Section 503 / 506 IPC // Section 351 – 351(2)BNS
- Obscene/Abusive Language: Section 294 IPC / Section 356 BNS
- Harassment/Stalking if repeated: Section 354D IPC / Section 80 BNS

Mens Rea:

The threats were deliberate, conscious, and repeated, reflecting clear intent to intimidate and disturb peace.

➤ **Fabrication / False Accusation by Physics Wallah Teacher/Students⁰⁴(05/09/2025)**

- After the incidents, the teacher and students falsely claimed that residents present at the scene took a shovel to harm them, in front of police officers and an advocate(myself).
- In reality, no residents carried any weapons, and the only persons present inside the premises were the students attempting recording.
- While entering the main gate, we strictly followed the police officers. Entry into the premises was made only by the police officers, myself (as a female advocate), and three male residents, solely for the purpose of observing and video-recording the situation to ensure transparency and to protect all parties from exactly such fabricated allegations against anyone. This constitutes a false accusation against both the residents and the police/advocate present at the scene.

Applicable Laws:

- Giving false information to public servant: IPC 182 / BNS 227
- False charge of offense with intent to injure: IPC 211 / BNS 230
- Defamation against advocate(myself): IPC 500 - 501 / BNS 354
- False statements affecting public servants: IPC 228 – 229 / BNS 233

Mens Rea:

The false claim was deliberate and intentional, aimed to mislead authorities and protect the offenders from accountability.

➤ **Negligence of Property Owner / Authorized Leaseholder**

Owner/authorized leaseholder was informed @8250394279 but failed to supervise tenants, demonstrating gross negligence, while lying of arriving to the scene and then switching off the electronic device when called by residents and police officer.

Applicable Laws:

- Endangering Safety through Negligence: Section 336 IPC / Section 336 BNS
- Criminal Liability by Inaction: Section 109 IPC / BNS 56
- Section 3(2) West Bengal Public Order Act, 1973
- Tenancy Responsibility: Section 19 WB Premises Tenancy Act, 1997

➤ **Legal Note on Transition of Laws**

As of 01/07/2024, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhinyam (BSA) replaced IPC, CrPC, and Evidence Act.

In West Bengal, police may refer to older statutes during this transitional period.

Both old and new provisions are cited for clarity.

➤ **Action Required**

- Register FIR against tenants (age verification required) and negligent owner/leaseholder.
- Invoke BNSS 151 / CrPC 151 for preventive measures without punitive action for minors.
- Examine electronic devices for attempted recording.
- Summon guardians/parents and Physics Wallah authorities for corrective measures.
- Ensure JJ Act compliance for minors.
- Written undertakings from minors not to repeat acts.
- Hold owner strictly accountable for supervision since this is not the first time, the problem is faced by his/her tenant.
- Furnish tenant identities to residents for safety.
- Vacate premises as soon as possible, with strict action taken by authorities to prevent further threat.

➤ **Acquisition of Official Student List**

1. **Police Authority to Acquire List:** The Officer-in-Charge (OC) shall acquire an official list of all Physics Wallah students residing at the said property from PW management for lawful investigation and community safety purposes. (CrPC, S.91 / BNSS, S.179)
2. **Required Contents of the List:** Student Full Name/ Government-issued Identity Number/ Parent/Guardian Contact Details (for minors) (JJ Act, 2015, S.74)
3. **Official Certification:** The OC shall sign, stamp, and attach the list to this FIR as an official annexure. (CrPC, S.76 / BNSS, S.169)
4. **Provision to Advocate:** One certified copy of the list shall be provided to the undersigned advocate for lawful custody.
- **Purpose: Monitoring repeat offenses, ensuring community safety, and preventive measures. (Advocates Act, 1961, S.30; Evidence Act, 1872, S.76 / BSA, S.76)**
5. **Confidentiality & Minor Protection:** All details of minors are strictly confidential and governed by JJ Act, 2015, S.74. I as an advocate shall ensure no disclosure to unauthorized persons, and the list shall be used only for lawful protective purposes.
6. **Advocate's Supervision & Monitoring Role:** The certified copy allows the advocate to:
 - a) Verify the identities of tenants in case of future threats or disturbances.
 - b) Liaise with police to ensure preventive actions.
 - c) Take appropriate steps for vacancy of premises if repeated violations occur. (JJ Act, 2015, S.74; Advocates Act, 1961, S.30; CrPC, S.91 / BNSS, S.179)
