Sir,

I, Smt. Sunita Chhetri, W/O Sri Suresh Chhetri, resident of Stalin Nagar, Road No. 6, Upper Bagdogra, P.O. & P.S. Bagdogra, Dist. Darjeeling, do hereby bring to your kind notice that on 28/08/2025 at about 2.25 P.M. my daughter Shweta Chhetri aged about 13 years and her friend Shrishtika Rai, D/O Sri Jagat Rai aged about 11 years alongwith other students of Army Public School, Bengdubi while returning from their school in a Toto. Suddenly one school bus bearing no. **WB 73A 1188 (EICHER)** coming in a high speed turned the bus towards the Toto and hit the Toto from its back side near a small NALA near Kamalpur Tea Factory resulting which all the students inside the Toto scattered on the road. The Bus driver was driving the vehicle very rashly and in a negligent manner. He was totally in a drunken condition. Immediately several passersby rushed to the spot and rescued the students from the spot and they took the injured students to nearby 158 Base Hospital, Bengdubi for their treatment.

Seeing the People rushing towards him, the driver of the offending vehicle fled away from the spot. My daughter Shweta Chhetri and her friend Shrishtika Rai have got several bleeding injuries on their person including some internal injuries also.

Sir, the accident was caused due to the rash and negligent driving by the driver of the said offending vehicle bearing No. WB 73A 1188 (EICHER). The injuries on the persons of my daughter Shweta Chhetri and her friend Shrishtika Rai are grievous in nature.

I, therefore, request you to take immediate legal action against the driver of the offending vehicle bearing No. WB 73A 1188 (EICHER) considering the circumstances herein before stated. The delay in lodging of this may kindly be condoned as the conditions of the patients are very serious and there is no one to look after and take care of them.
