**Subject:** Formal Complaint Regarding a Fatal Hit-and-Run Incident

**Respected Sir/Madam,**

I, Kamini Roy, resident of Vivekananda nagar, Salugara, Siliguri Ward no 42, Siliguri, am writing to file a formal complaint regarding a tragic and grievous incident that occurred on 05.09.2025 at around 12:00 PM to 2:00 PM near Mahananda River, Champasari, resulting in the death of Suman Roy my son, who died on the spot due to a hit-and-run by an vehicle.

My son was returning home after taking bath in the Mahananda River, as per the information gathered at the scene, when a truck owned by **Krishna Rai**, resident of Champasari, Dakhin Palash, Siliguri (red and blue coloured, licenced plate no.:- **WB 73 3321**) involved in illegal sand transportation from the river, approached at a dangerously high speed in broad daylight and ran over my son. The truck driver did not stop after the incident and fled the scene immediately without offering any assistance or informing the authorities.

The Local resident identified the truck driver namely **Anil Orao**, resident of Champasari, Dakhin Palash, Siliguri, who is known in the area as a habitual offender. He has been repeatedly engaged in illegal sand transportation from the river, often driving recklessly to evade law enforcement.

Eyewitness accounts suggest that the vehicle was moving at an unreasonable speed, apparently in an attempt to evade police or avoid being caught for the unauthorized transport of sand from the riverbed, which is a violation of environmental and mining regulations. This reckless behaviour directly resulted in the fatal accident.

The impact of the collision was so severe that my son (Suman Roy) succumbed to injuries immediately. Several bystanders and passersby witnessed the accident and tried to assist, but unfortunately, he could not be saved. The hit-and-run driver made no attempt to slow down or take responsibility for the grievous harm caused.

What makes this loss even more devastating is that my son, at just 21 years old, was the sole bread earner of our family. He was working hard to support us and build a better future. His sudden and unjust death has left our family not only shattered emotionally but also vulnerable financially. The pain of losing a child under such horrific circumstances is beyond words.

This incident has not only resulted in the untimely and tragic death of my son Suman Roy but has also caused immense emotional trauma to the family and community. It is imperative that the responsible individual be identified and brought to justice under the relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, The Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 and Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 read with West Bengal Minor Mineral Concession Rules, 2002.

I seek your immediate intervention to lodge an FIR against the driver namely Anil Orao, and the truck owner Namely Krishna Rai Bioth resident of Champasari, Dakshin Palash, Siliguri and ensure justice is served at the earliest.

You are, therefore, requested to intervene into the matter and to take necessary action as per law.
