I, the undersigned, Laxmi Prasad  
Chhetry, IPS Retd. DIG of Police resident of  
Deepnagar, Khaptail have the honour  
to report that one mobile phone as detail  
given above had been snatched away  
from the possession of my grand-daughter  
named Miss Reena Kanwar aged about  
25 years by unknown snatcher in the  
crowded vegetables market of Matigara  
Bazar nearby the PHARMACY while doing  
f/2 over

Weekly shopping of vegetables for the family by cutting open the side bag hanging by the right shoulder with the phone inside it from behind in a jerk making an opening of about 6 inches wide by probably using a sharp knife/ scissors. In this action Miss Reena became aware of shoulder-bag pulling in a jerk and cried out "CHOR, CHOR, CHOR" but in vain because of the 'crowd in large scale that neither she could see the snatcher nor the crowd around her. And thus we lost the phone registered in the name of Miss Reena Kanwar and hence the complaint for registering an FIR for causing investigation towards recovery of the snatched phone.

For which act of your kindness I shall ever remain grateful to you.
