Sub: Complaint against Shri Soumen Nandi (Partner, Aastha Medical), Shri Sujit Agarwal (brother of Shri Ajit Agarwal, Partner, Aastha Medical) and others for threatening, hooliganism, and illegal activities against the Office Bearers and Members of Bengal Chemists & Druggists Association.

Sir,

I, Subrata Ghosh, son of Late Phani Bhusan Ghosh, presently Zonal Secretary of the Bengal Chemists & Druggists Association, Siliguri Zone, most respectfully submit the following facts for your kind attention and urgent intervention:

1. On 17.09.2025 at about 2:00 PM, a group of 7–8 suspicious young men entered the wholesale medicine market area at Sisir Bhadury Sarani, Kshudirampally, Siliguri. They began taking photographs and videos of our members' shops on their mobile phones.

When questioned, they attempted to flee. One of them was caught by our members, who disclosed that they had been sent by Shri Ajit Agarwal and Shri Soumen Nandi, Partners of Aastha Medical, to record the wholesale market. However, before further details could be obtained, he managed to escape, leaving behind his mobile phone.

2. At that time, most of our members were busy upgrading their computer systems due to the revised GST structure, and normal business activities were already affected.

3. Shortly thereafter, Shri Soumen Nandi telephoned me and threatened me with dire consequences, alleging that our members had beaten his men. He shouted abusive words and clearly issued threats to my life.

4. Following this, 50-70 antisocial elements suddenly entered the Kshudirampally medicine market, creating a nuisance, hurling filthy abuses, and intimidating our members. Within 15 minutes, Shri Sujit Agarwal (brother of Shri Ajit Agarwal, Partner, Aastha Medical) and Shri Soumen Nandi arrived at the market with another 20-30 miscreants.

They openly threatened to kill me (Subrata Ghosh, Zonal Secretary) and Shri Amit Agarwal, District Secretary, while abusing us and our members in the presence of police personnel.

5. The mob, armed with sharp weapons, forcefully entered shops, pushed aside customers, and even attempted to snatch cash and goods. Their sole motive was to create terror, disturb peace and harmony, and physically assault us.

Shri Sujit Agarwal was repeatedly shouting: "Ei de to arms ta, sala ke mere jabo" (Give me the weapon, I will kill him). His murderous intent was only thwarted due to the mass gathering of local businessmen who resisted.

6. This entire incident was pre-planned and orchestrated by Shri Ajit Agarwal, Shri Sujit Agarwal, and Shri Soumen Nandi to destabilize our wholesale medicine market and terrorize law-abiding businessmen.

Impact:

Due to these incidents, our members are terrified and traumatized. They are unable to carry out their business peacefully, and there is a strong apprehension that they may be attacked again. Many shopkeepers have even expressed fear of keeping their shops open tomorrow.

Prayer:

In these circumstances, I most humbly request your good office to:

- Take immediate legal action against Shri Soumen Nandi, Shri Sujit Agarwal, Shri Ajit Agarwal, and their associates for their unlawful acts.
- Book the culprits under relevant sections of laws for criminal intimidation, rioting, attempt to assault/kill, trespass, and unlawful assembly.
- Ensure adequate police protection to maintain law and order in the wholesale medicine market.

Your early intervention will help restore peace and safeguard the lives and property of our members.
