Sub: Written Complaint

I, Smt. Shila Ray, w/o late Sanat Kr. Roy, resident of Manibha, Purba Chayan Para, Dabgram, Ghugumali, Dist- Jalpaiguri, do hereby lodge this complaint regarding a series of unlawful acts committed by my daughter-in-law Moumita Majumder, r/o- Suryasen Street, 1 no. Dabgram, Rabindra Sarani, Siliguri.

That Moumita Majumder is legally wedded wife of my son Soumyajit Roy and their social marriage was solemnized on 10.07.2017 as per Hindu rites, ceremonies and customs and subsequently their marriage was registered under Hindu Marriage Act. At no point did I or my family demand or accept any form of dowry, either in cash or kind. Out of the wedlock one male child namely Rishav Roy was born on 23.04.2019.

Over the course of their matrimonial life, their relationship became increasingly strained due to her rough, High-tempered, greedy, quarrelsome, uncooperative, suspicious, dominating, aggressive and violent behavior. She frequently subjected me and my son to mental and physical abuse, using harsh language and sarcastic remarks, which caused immense emotional distress and depression.

That in or around August 2024, she without any reason deserted her husband and left the matrimonial home. Despite my son's repeated requests for her to return and reconcile, she continued to visit sporadically, staying briefly and then leaving again. Such incidents continued for almost regular basis.

On 02.08.2025, she came to our house with her father and others and took away all her personal gold jewellery that she had brought at the time of marriage. However, on 18.09.2025 at about 12 noon, she suddenly came to the house and went into the bedroom, and took away a pair of ear ring weighing approximately 2.950 grams belonging to me, along with Rs. 55,000/- in cash from the wardrobe locker. She also forcefully took the minor son, Rishav Roy, assuring us that she would return him shortly. However, more than 24 hours have passed, and she has refused to bring him back. We discovered the theft on the morning of 19.09.2025 when I checked the locker.

I request that appropriate legal action be initiated under the relevant provisions of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (B.N.S.S.), 2023 to ensure justice and recovery of the stolen property and custody of the child.
