I, Debarata Sinha, Son of A.N. Sinha, Resident of Khawakhari, Matigara, Siliguri, would like to draw your sincere attention over the concerned facts and incident enumerated herein below:

Received on 22.09.25 at 23:25 hrs vide NBMC SP GDE NO - 766 dt 22/9/25 Original - Complaint forwarded to I/C Matigara PS for starting a specific case under proper Section of Law.

1. That on 19/09/2025 I being the manager Staff of Avijit Roy (Proprietor of Geniune Lab) at Shanti Lodge, Ratanlal Brahman Sarani, P.O. Susrata nagar, P.S. Matigara, at around 6:00 am while I opened my Geniune Lab to run my business suddenly I found my landlord Bipul Saha along with his daughter in law and daughter namely Konka Mondal Saha, Soma Saha, Ishak Saha also with his son namely Rishav Saha and other hooligans namely Dipankar Ghosh vehemently entered my shop premises and vehemently tried to evict me from the said shop room at the abovementioned address. They are taking advantage of being ladies in person; they vehemently forced me to leave the shop's premises illegally and threatened me to implicate me in a false criminal case.

2. That when I called the police of the concerned jurisdiction, they rushed to my rental premises and accordingly, I showed them original certified copy of the order sheet subject to Title suit No. 107/2025 before the Ld, Civil Judge Senior Division at Siliguri filed by Avijit Roy the tenant of the rental premises, against the landlord, namely Bipul Saha where the Ld.

Court was pleased to pass and junction order directing the defendant, namely Bipul Saha, to be restrained from creating any act to dispossess Avijit Roy, i.e., the plaintiff, from the rental premises. Eventually, after showing all the documents to the concerned police, the said above-mentioned person, Bipul Saha, and his associates violated the court's order and created a huge chaos at my tenanted shop, and furthermore, they damaged my furniture, equipment worth of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty Thousand Only) and created a serious violation of court orders in presence of the police personals.

3. That even the said Bipul Saha and his associates broke away the wooden door at the back side of the shop premises, creating a serious act to concern about the security of my shop room.

That I will be highly grateful towards the concerned authority to take immediate action against the illegal act and deeds of the said Bipul Saha and his associates mentioned above.
