Sir,

In producing herewith one arrested accused person namely Mukesh Thakur- 28yrs s/o Sudharshan Thakur of Kamalanagar, PO Salugara ward no-42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri along with following seized articles viz:-

- i) 05 (Five) pieces of sealed Domestic Gas cylinder (LPG)
- ii) 01 (one) empty Domestic Gas Cylinder (LPG)
- iii) 02 pieces of Mini Gas cylinder (LPG).
- iv) 01(one) empty Commercial Gas cylinder (LPG)
- v) 01 (one) 'T' Nozzle gas supplier
- vi) One orange colour gas pipe which is fitted with Gas supplier 'T' Nozzle and regulator
- vii) 01(one) electronic weighing machine. (Total cylinder Big-07 & small-02)

I ASI Dipak Karmakar of Bhaktinagar Police station under Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that today i.e. on 09.10.25 at 12.45 hours when myself along with officers and forces of Bhaktinagar PS working out an information vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE no-339 Dt. 09.10.25 at Kamalanagar, ward no-42, then an information received from reliable source that a huge numbers of stolen domestic and commercial gas cylinders are dumped in the shop of one Mukesh Thakur style as Shanti Oven repairing at Kamalanagar, ward no-42, under Bhaktinagar PS.

Accordingly the information communicated the same to I/C of PS. As per direction I along with the team SI Yuel Lepcha, SI Srimanta Chatterjee, ASI Dhurbo Misra, and const/374 Debraj Biswas all of Bhaktinagar PS had been to the place to work out the information and two local witnesses were requested to presence at the time of search and seizure namely 1) Raju Bisunkey s/o Ram Bahadur Bisunkey of Vivekanandanagar, ward no-42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and (2) Raffel Gurung s/o Simon Gurung of Cherujote, Prakashnagar, ward no-42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri entered in the shop of the above noted person and during search the above gas cylinders along with re-filling nozzles having above description were recovered .It also found that the re-filling process was continue. On interrogation the above noted accused disclosed his name and identity as stated above and on demand he failed to produce any document/license in support of possession of huge number of Gas cylinders and also made incoherent statement. So, all the gas cylinders along with nozzles were seized under proper seizure list.

Under the above circumstances it is evident that the accused person above named committed theft in respect of LPG cylinders and was transporting the same to somewhere else for disposal of stolen property after refilling the same from big cylinder to small cylinder. I tried to serve notice u/s 35(3) BNSS but he refused to accept the notice. I arrested him u/s 35 (3) of BNSS after explaining him about ground of arrest issuing proper memo of arrest and taken into custody. Whole process of search and seizure duly audio & VDO graphed. Seizure was made in between 13.40hrs to 13.55 hrs.

Hence, I request you to kindly start a specific case against the arrested accused namely Mukesh Thakur-28yrs s/o Sudharshan Thakur of Kamalanagar, PO Salugara ward no-42, PS Bhaktinagar Dist Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
