Subject: Written Complaint Regarding Theft of Jewellery (Approx. ₹8-9 Lakhs) and Cash
₹1,50,000/- from My Residence at Samarnagar

Respected Sir,

I, Bablu Ray, son of Sri Lalan Ray, resident of Samarnagar Colony, near G.M. Public School, beside Shiv Sangh Club, Post Office Champasari, P.S. Pradhan Nagar, District Darjeeling, would like to lodge a written complaint regarding a theft that occurred at my residence today.

At around 11:00-11:30 a.m., my father's health suddenly deteriorated, and I took him to Neotia Hospital. About ten minutes later, my sister locked all the doors and the boundary gate of our house and left for the hospital with my mother. Despite being anxious about my father's health, she ensured that all rooms, wardrobes (almirahs), and the boundary gate were securely locked before leaving.

When they returned at around 3:00-3:15 p.m., They noticed that the back entrance of the house had been forcefully broken. It appeared that someone had entered the premises in their absence. She immediately raised an alarm, and our neighbours gathered. She also began video recording the entire scene.

Upon inspection, we found that my brother (Raju Ray) almirah was broken, and the locker had been opened using the key kept inside. All the jewellery worth approximately ₹8-9 lakhs and cash amounting to ₹20,000/- were missing. In my mother's room, we found that the dressing table was damaged, and cash of ₹1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only) was missing as well.

I, therefore, request you to kindly register this complaint and take immediate and strict action against the unknown person(s) who committed this theft by taking advantage of our absence. I further request you to kindly help in recovering the stolen jewellery and cash at the earliest.

I, along with my family members, assure you of our full cooperation during the investigation and will comply with all formalities as required by the police authorities.
