Dear Sir,

I Aruna Limbu, W/o Lt. Debkumar Limbu, resident of Bhuttabari, PS- Bagdogra, Darjeeling lodge this complaint with the information that on 03/10/2025 at approximately 05:30 pm, my son named Dharendra Limbu was moving towards Bagdogra from Bhuttabari while he reached near Bhuttabari Shiv Mandir at that time one motorcycle bearing no. WE74BE2801 dashed my son, by rash and negligent driving causing him to be thrown onto the side of the road, where he sustained serious and bloody injuries. The local people took my son to Bagdogra Health Centre from where he referred to NBMC & Hospital for better treatment where he was admitted for treatment but he couldn't survive and succumbed to his death.

The post mortem of my son was done as per Matigara PS U/D Case Number 1106/2025, dated 04/10/2025, at NBMC & Hospital Siliguri.

Due to being busy with my son's funeral works I couldn't lodge the complaint earlier.

Hence today I am submitting this written complaint to you, with a request to take appropriate action against the driver of the offending motorcycle bearing no. WB74BE2801 to ensure justice.
