Respected Sir,

I Jhariya Roy, aged about 75 years, Son of Late. Benani Roy, Resident of
Adarsh Nagar Colony, P.S. Siliguri, Dist:- Darjeeling, begs to state as follows:-

1. That I am the owner of 3 No's of land along with tin shaded pucca house situated in an around Jotymoy Colony, Nich Para, Ward no. 32, P.S. NJP, Dist:- Jalpaiguri, where my sons namely (a) Andaru Roy (b) Bablu Roy and (c) Subhas Roy along with his wife and children's used to reside there.
2. That in the month of March my above mentioned sons and two of my daughter in-law was falsely implicated in a NJP P.S. Case No. 125/2025 dated 01/03/2025 and soon after that my three houses was locked key by the IO of the above mentioned case namely SI Paresh Barman.
3. That after the initiation of the case my daughter- in-law was arrested by the IO of the above mentioned case and later on she was enlarged on bail by the Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Jalpaiguri and later on my son namely Andaru Roy was granted Anticipatory Bail Ld. District & Sessions Judge, Jalpaiguri and Daughter in-law namely Kanika Roy was granted Anticipatory Bail the Hon'ble Hight Court at Calcutta, Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri.

That today i.e. 10/10/2025 at about 12:00 to 12:30 PM I received a call from one of my sons neighbor that my above mentioned house where my sons used to stay which was locked and key by the IO of the above mentioned case during the investigation has been forcefully broken by unknown 25-30 miscreants who came in a truck from Shaktighar area and broke entered the 3 houses and took cash of Rs. 1,12,000/- and gold jeweler's weighing 25 grams and and all other house hold articles and utensil's and furniture and also damaged the entire house of (a) Andaru Roy and took cash of Rs. 95,000/- and gold jeweler's weighing 55 grams and all other house hold articles and utensil's and furniture and also damaged the entire house of (b) Bablu Roy and took cash of Rs. 15,000/- and gold jeweler's weighing 65 grams and all other house hold articles and utensil's and furniture and also damaged the entire house of (c) Subhash Roy; in a broad daylight.

5. That all the above mentioned incident took place today in a broad daylight which shows that they have no fear of law and order and are fearless and dangerous in nature and can do anything in the near future if my sons along with their wife and children tries to stay in my above mentioned house.

I therefore request you to kindly take necessary legal action against the aforesaid culprits for the ends of justice.
