Sub : FIR against truck driver and others for transporting coal illegally.
Sir,

In producing herewith two following accused person namely 1) Sarban Kumar (35) s/o Debnarayan Singh of Nayatala Gangelli PS Purnia Dist Purnia Bihar 2) Suresh Kumar S/O Arjun Roy of Baikatpur PS Khoshrupur Dist Patna Bihar under arrest and one Truck No- BR 38 GA 8272 loaded with Coal under seizure, I/ASI Manoj Majumdar of NJP PS do hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 12.10.25 at 17. 15 hrs, I received an information from a reliable source that one truck bearing Registration No. BR 38 GA 8272 loaded with illegally mined coal from Arunachal Pradesh was supposed to proceed to Bihar following National Highway 31 via Jotiakaliand Fulbari. After sharing the information with the I/C NJP P.S. I along with ASI Nilam Swarnkar C/ 453 Uttam Dey NVF 0070 Nipen Roy and force left for Canal road under NJP PS to work out the information. Reaching at Canal Road we kept watch on the traffic flow on NH clandestinely. After some times dully identified by our source we noticed one truck having Registration No. BR 38 GA 8272 was coming from Jalpaiguri side following NH 31. After noticing Police team, the driver tried to escape away by high speed. After a hot chase we could be able to detain the said truck at Gotmabari. On interrogation the driver and helper of the truck disclosed their identity as noted above. We also found that the truck was loaded with coal. On demand the driver of said truck could not be able to produce any document like Transit Paper, Mining paper, Invoice, GST Bill etc, in respect of the loaded coal. On interrogation they furnished incoherent statements. they only confessed that the coal getting loaded from a place in Arunachal Pradesh was transported to Bihar.

Under the above facts and circumstances there is strong reason to believe that the above noted driver and helper in connivance with others procured the said amount of coal fraudulently with knowledge to be stolen property to sell the same to other state for their wrongful gain. So, I seized the said truck loaded with coals under proper seizure list in between 19:25 hrs and 19:40 hrs from the possession of the said driver and helper in presence of witnesses. Then I arrested them after issuing him proper memo of arrest, serving the paper of ground of arrest at 19:55 hrs. they stated that since long he along with his associates have been doing this business of coal following this manner for their illegal gain.

Hence, it is requested to register a specific case against Sarban Kumar (35) s/o Debnarayan Singh of Nayatala Gangelli PS Purnia Dist Purnia Bihar 2) Suresh Kumar S/O Arjun Roy of Baikatpur PS Khoshrupur Dist Patna Bihar and others under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation.
