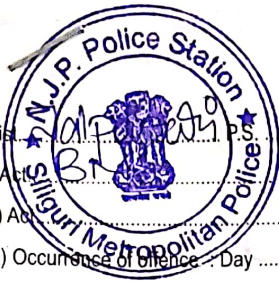

Subject: FIR regarding brutal attack on driver and his assistant and attempt to loot cows and cash by
few members of Bajrang Dal

Esteemed Sir

I, M.d. Faruque resident of Joydeb Bhita, Fulbari Hat would like to lodge this First Information Report regarding a violent incident that took place on 14th October 2025 at 1 p.m. near Madar More (Opposite of Thalamus), Fulbari.

On the said date and time, a group of individuals, reportedly members of the Bajrang Dal, brutally attacked me and my assistant when I was driving an animal vehicle (Vehicle No. WB 73D7592) carrying cows. The cows were being lawfully transported, and all relevant legal documents for the animals were present.

During the attack, the assailants used lethal weapons to physically assault me and my assistant. They also attempted to snatch the cash and cows from us. This incident was not only violent but also clearly motivated to disrupt peace and communal harmony in the area.

It is important to mention that similar incidents have been reported earlier, including one at Matigara earlier this year, where the same group was allegedly involved in attacking lawful cattle traders.

The owners of the cows being transported on the said day are - Mr. Saherul Haque, Mr. Ashraf Alam, Mr. Abdul Khaleque, Mr. Md. Faruq. All of them possess proper and valid documents proving the legality of their cattle ownership and transport.

Such repeated violent acts by these unlawful groups are creating social unrest and communal tension in otherwise peaceful areas like Fulbari and its surroundings.

Therefore, I request you to kindly register this FIR, initiate a thorough investigation, and take strict legal action against all those responsible under relevant sections of the BNS and other applicable laws.

Prompt police intervention is essential to ensure justice for the victims and to maintain peace and harmony in the region.
