Sir,

In producing herewith 01 (one) arrested accused person namely Tapas Das (20) s/o Kasi Naba Das of Sadhur Hat, PS- Mathabhanga, Dist. Cooch Behar (Not Verified) along with seized articles as mentioned below:.

- 1) One brown color celotape wrapped packet containing said to be Ganja weighting 4.890 kg marked as Ex-'A',
- 2) One brown color celotape wrapped packet containing said to be Ganja weighting 4.920 kg marked as Ex-'B',
- 3) One black color travel bag on which written 'NIKE' marked as EX- 'C' in which Ex-A & Ex-B were kept inside the bag wrapping with a Bed Sheet printed color ,
4. One key pad mobile phone ' VILLAON' with Sim card, battery, in a active condition,
5. Cash amounting Rs. 1400/- Indian currency different notes,
6. One small bottle of perfume "Reebok"

I, SI Chabilal Sinha of New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC, do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that today on 18-10-2025 at about 18:55 hrs, I received an information from my credible source that one persons is illegally carrying with them a huge quantity of Ganja, a controlled substance under the NDPS Act. He is expected to cross through, Tinbatti more area under NJP P.S very soon with the intention of boarding a bus from junction for its clandestine disposal and their personal gain. This information suggests a strong likelihood of a cognizable offense under the NDPS Act being committed. If not acted immediately they would succeed to smuggle the same

I reduced the information in writing vide NJP PS GDE No. 871, dated 18.10.2025 and I intimated the information to Shri Aviji Dutta, Inspector of Police, New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC, and after obtaining necessary order at about 19:10 hrs myself, along with a team consisting of i. Myself, SI Tanmay Kundu, ASI Manoj majumdar, C/ 453 Uttam Dey C/1462 Sajan Tamang, VP 13 Jamirul Islam , VP 08 Laxman Roy took departure from New Jalpaiguri PS for Tinbatti more area under NJP P.S along with laptop, portable printer, weighing machine, Drug Testing Kits and other necessary documents articles required for operation availing Govt. vehicle to work out the information and the same was diarized vide NJP P.S GDE No. 873, dated 18.10.2025 and MCC No. 242/2025 dated: 18.10.2025.

At about 19:35, myself and raid team reached at Tinbatti More area under NJP P.S, and met my source and he briefed me about the detail information. I then looked up

for public witnesses and found 02 persons namely: i) Sabad Ali (28) s/o Afajuddin of Tinbatti More PS NJP Dist Jalpaiguri ii) Ajay Roy (25) s/o Lt Satya Mohan Roy of Tinbatti near Hindi School Ground PS NJP Dist Jalpaiguri and briefed them the information in hand in a nutshell after listening to the information they both voluntarily agreed to stand as witness for the entire process of search and seizure. Thereafter, we ambushed at Tinbatti more bus stand under NJP PS. I contacted with videographer namely Tapan Mandal and asked him to come to the spot immediately and make video graphy of whole process of search and seizure if happen.

At about 19:45 hrs, we saw one person was standing at Tinbatti More, Bus stand area under NJP P.S area. My source identified one person as our suspects accordingly we detained him. We then cordoned him and I introduced myself and the raid team members as Police personal showing our Govt. ID proofs, I then appraised them about the information in hand and started to examine him. During examination, he stated his names as Tapas Das (20) s/o Kasi Naba Das of Sadhur Hat, PS-Mathabhanga, Dist. Cooch Behar. I asked him if he had any ID proof he stated that he had no ID proof now. On further questioning, the above noted detainee made contradictory statements at different times but finally he confessed that he was in conscious possession of huge quantities of Ganja which were packed in sealed plastic packets concealed inside his travel bag which he was carrying. I then immediately as per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) I explained the above noted detainee and the same was given to him separately in writing stating that he have legal right to tender his personal search in front of a magistrate or a gazetted officer duly empowered under section 42 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended).

I then served Notice U/S 50 of NDPS Act to the detainee whether he was willing to be searched in presence of the police Gazetted officer or any gazetted officer of other department. In reply, he made his written consent to be searched in presence of the Police Gazetted Officer. I then contact to Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector, SPC for his presence at PO and stand as a gazetted officer.

At about 20:35 hrs, Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector, SPC arrived on the spot and I introduced him as Gazetted officer to the detained persons and the independent witness. I then narrated the development to him in a nutshell.

Thereafter, Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector, SPC served Notice U/S 103 BNSS in writing to the above mentioned detained person and that, if he wish, he may search every member of the searching team and the vehicles with us before the search of his person and his belongings. Then, the detainee denied to searched me and other raid team including Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector, SPC and Govt. vehicle as well as the above noted 02 public witnesses. Accordingly, I prepared a Nil seizure list. Duly signed by the detainee and raid team and witnesses.
