(Since Deceased), is/was my husband who was carrying on a business as a Driver

Sir, on 23/10/2025 at about 10:25 A.M. my husband Md. Jalaluddin  
Mahamad (since deceased) left the house towards in front of Desun Hospital side for  
some work purpose by his 3 wheeler goods carrier vehicle bearing Registration No.  
WB-73F-3038 accompanied with my Daughter namely Kashmira Khatoon (13  
years) and my Mother -in-law Namely Sakina Khatoon and my husband was driving  
the said vehicle.

That at about 11:00 A.M. I was informed by some local people of our locality  
that while my husband accompanied with my Daughter and Mather-in-law were  
returning towards our house at that time, one vehicle being no -WB74BB-8887 hit  
the vehicle of my husband, near Desun Hospital on the Asian High Way -II, and for  
that tragic accident my husband, my daughter and my mother-in-law got grievous  
injuries and all of them were taken to the Desun Hospital and their treatment are  
going on but on 24/10/2025 my Husband Md. Jalaluddin Mahamad expired in the  
said Hospital.

Sir, due to the pathetic death of my deceased husband in a road accident, I  
along with my other family members were remained busy for performing the last  
rituals of my said husband and also with mental trauma and anxiety, for which  
some delay has been caused for lodging this written complaint and the same may  
be condoned.

I, therefore, request you to kindly investigate into the matter properly and  
please take necessary legal action against the driver of the said vehicle as per the  
provisions of law and obliged thereby
