Respected Sir

With due respect and humble submission I beg to inform you that I ASI Dipak Karmakar now attached at Bhaktinagar Police station under your kind control.

Today on 06.11.25 at about 00.20 hrs myself along with Const/1426 Prasanta Kumar Dutta and CVF/014 Labonnomoy Barman left for night mobile duty at PS area in mufti dress as per order vide Bhaktinagar PS GDE No-257 dated 06.11.25.

At about 01.15 hrs while we are engaged in mobile duty received an information from on duty officer of Bhaktinagar PS that one chaos was going on between two parties at Sevoke road near Open House PAB & BAR. This refers to Bhaktinagar PS GDE no-258 dated 06.11.25. Received that information immediately myself along with force reached at PO and found that two parties engaged in physical altercation & assaulting each other, causing disturbance and fear in the locality. Despite efforts to pacify the situation, the quarrel continued, creating law and order issues. I interfere the matter and tried to stop them and subsequently one party fled away from the spot and two guys of another party was found injured and one of them got bleeding injury on his eye. Both the guys were intoxicated and out of their sense & we were finding difficulty to control them even after disclosing out identity as police personnel. But suddenly one injured person attacked me and my forces and assaulted us with fist and blow and other one was instigating him, then we are used minimum required force to control them. After that both tried to flee away & one of them succeeded while other one who assaulted us, dashed with a motor cycle on sevoke road in course of running away from P.O and sustained further injury. Myself along with force immediate took the injured person with my vehicle and shifted him to Siliguri Dist Hospital for his treatment. At that time, he disclosed his name as Mr Ben Ashish Moktan S/o Edward Tamang of 7th mile Kalimpong & also disclosed the name of his associate as Mohan Zindal. The injured namely Ben Ashish Moktan had been creating chaos at hospital and also misbehaving with hospital staff accordingly I informed Siliguri Police station and ASI Debasish Das of Siliguri Police station was came to hospital to control the situation as the injured person tried to ransack the Hospital property also tried to beat the staff of that hospital who was dressing him. I myself, Const/1426 Prasanta Kumar Dutta and CVF/014 Labonnomoy Barman were also treated at Siliguri Sadar Hospital. Thereafter I informed his family members about this matter and they came at Siliguri Dist hospital and took away their son after discharging from hospital.

Those persons used criminal force and caused obstruction upon police personnel on duty to deter police personnel from discharging their lawful Govt. duty and also assaulted public servant. Considering the above facts and circumstances, I therefore pray before your kind honour necessary legal action may kindly be taken against Mr Ben Ashish Moktan S/o Edward Tamang of 7th mile Kalimpong and Mohan Zindal and start a case under proper sections of law and arrange for its proper investigation.
