Subject: Written Complaint

Respected Sir,

I, Smt. Gita Thakur, aged about 40 years, wife of Late Sudhama Thakur, permanent resident of Suktabari, Nishiganj, P.S. - Nishiganj, District - Cooch Behar, beg to lodge the following written complaint for your kind and immediate action under law:

- 1. **That**, in the month of **September 2025**, I came to **Siliguri** for employment as a **housemaid** at the residence of **Smt. Sangita Prasad**, wife of **Shri Tushar Prasad**, residing at Silver Oaks Building, near Sinclairs Hotel, Block-2, Room No. 10/CP/S, under P.S. Pradhannagar, District Darjeeling.
- 2. **That**, I was employed by the said **Smt. Sangita Prasad** on a verbal agreement that she would pay me a monthly remuneration of **Rs. 15,000/-** for my household work. Accordingly, I discharged my duties with full sincerity and honesty for a continuous period of two months.
- 3. That, despite repeated requests, Smt. Sangita Prasad did not pay me any wages for the said two months, and later she flatly denied to make payment of my due amount. Thereafter, I made several attempts to contact her telephonically, but she deliberately disconnected my calls and refused to respond.
- 4. That, on 09.11.2025 at around 11:30 hours, I, along with my brother Rajesh Thakur, went to the aforesaid residence of Smt. Sangita Prasad to have a peaceful discussion

regarding the pending remuneration and to seek clarification for non-payment. At that time, the security personnel informed **Shri Tushar Prasad**, husband of Sangita, who came downstairs and met us. He stated that his wife had gone to Bihar and that he had already paid the entire amount to her. After saying so, he left the place.

- 5. That, after about 10 to 15 minutes, Sawan Chouhan (nephew of Sangita), Mamata Chouhan (niece), and Gayatri Chouhan (sister of Sangita) came downstairs and, without any provocation, falsely accused me of having stolen a pair of earrings earlier. I strongly protested such false and defamatory allegations and questioned them as to why no police complaint was made earlier if such theft had actually occurred.
- 6. That, during this time, my brother Rajesh Thakur was recording a video of the incident on his mobile phone for our own safety. Suddenly, all the above-named persons jointly and voluntarily snatched the mobile phone from him, threw it on the floor, and physically assaulted both of us. They pushed us to the ground, kicked us repeatedly, and pulled me by my hair, thereby using criminal force upon me with intent to outrage my modesty.
- 7. That, they also brutally assaulted Rajesh Thakur, inflicting severe injuries on his forehead and near his eye, causing profuse bleeding and bodily pain, with full knowledge that such an act was likely to cause death.
- 8. That, immediately thereafter, we proceeded to Siliguri District Hospital, where Rajesh Thakur was admitted in the Emergency Department and is still under medical treatment.
- 9. That, the entire occurrence took place within the premises of the said Silver Oaks Building, which is covered by

CCTV surveillance.

10. That, the accused persons are influential and locally powerful, and have threatened me and my brother with dire consequences, including false implication in fabricated cases and forcible eviction from the Siliguri area, if we take any legal step against them.

Hence, I most humbly request you, Sir, to kindly register a case against the following accused persons: Smt. Sangita Prasad, Sawan Chouhan, Mamata Chouhan, Gayatri Chouhan for committing offences punishable under appropriate provisions of law,, and to take necessary legal action in the interest of justice.
