Subject: FIR against Vishnu Singh, Nandani Singh, Santi Devi and others for assault, abuse, theft, and criminal intimidation.

Respected Sir,

I, Usha Patel, wife of Raj Kumar Patel, resident of Tomba Jote, Zora Bridge, near Sporting Club, would like to lodge this complaint against Vishnu Singh, Nandani Singh, Santi Devi and others for physically assaulting and threatening me and my family members.

Today, at about 5:30 PM, when I was going to the ghat for Chhath Puja, Vishnu Singh and Nandani Singh started abusing my daughter and her husband in filthy language. They also started making obscene comments about me. Ignoring their words, I continued towards the ghat. However, they again misbehaved with my daughter and son-in-law and continued to pass vulgar remarks.

After that, I went to Vishnu's mother, Santi Devi, and complained about her son's behavior. Instead of controlling her son, she supported Vishnu and Nandani and started arguing with me. She even said threatening words like "tubhimaarkhayegi". When she and others tried to attack me, I ran away from there and went to perform my puja at the ghat.

A little while later, Santi Devi, Vishnu Singh, Nandani Singh, and a few other persons came to the ghat and, without saying anything, started beating me, my daughter, my son, and my son-in-law with fists and blows. Vishnu Singh tried to kill my son and son-in-law, while Nandani Singh and Santi Devi attacked me with a bamboo stick and lathi. They broke my spectacles, and when I fell to the ground, Santi Devi instructed her son to kill me.

During the assault, Santi Devi snatched away my 7-gram gold mangalsutra and 8-gram gold chain from my neck. I lost consciousness for a while, and before leaving, they threatened that if I or my family went to the police, we would face dire consequences. Out of fear, I initially stopped my son from taking any action.

After completing my Chhath Puja, while returning home, they again abused me and threatened to kill me. They attacked me and my son Satyam once more. When I realized our lives were in danger, I called the police for help. Still, they did not stop and tore my clothes. With the help of some local people, I was rescued from their attack.
