**Subject: Request for Registration of FIR for Criminal Trespass, Brutal Assault, Attempt to Murder and Outraging Modesty.**

**Respected Sir,**

I, Rahima Khatun, Wife of Md. Khomij, residing at Salbari, Nayabasti, Siliguri, West Bengal, most respectfully submit this written complaint for your urgent attention and necessary legal action. I am deeply distressed and traumatised by a violent incident that took place on **16/11/2025** at our residence, during which my husband was nearly killed and I myself was subjected to physical assault and humiliation.

On the above-mentioned date, at around the time my husband was installing and constructing a gate at the entrance of our house, a group of persons from our locality arrived together in a threatening and aggressive manner. The individuals involved were (1) **Md. Abdul, S/o Md. Khalil**, (2) **Tamirul, S/o Jainul**, (3) **Majibul, S/o Lalu**, (4) **Namirul, S/o Abdul Gaffar**, (5) **Abdul Gaffar**, (6) **Md. Kabbir, S/o Ghogholding**, (7) **Md. Nabir, S/o Ghogholding**, (8) **Ramisha Khatun, W/o Md. Nabir**, and (9) **Tamisha Khatun, W/o Jainul**. All of them came armed with dangerous weapons such as sickle, bamboo sticks, hammer, and iron rods, clearly showing their intention to cause serious harm.

Without any provocation, and without our permission, they forcibly entered our home. Immediately upon entering, they dragged my husband out towards the gate area. The men in the group began to brutally beat my husband, using the iron rods, bamboo sticks, and other weapons they had carried. They struck him repeatedly on his head, back, and various parts of his body. Their actions were deliberate, coordinated, and violent enough to show that their clear intention was to kill him. My husband struggled and cried out in pain, but the attackers continued to hit him mercilessly until he fell to the ground, seriously injured and unable to defend himself.

During this horrific situation, **Ramisha Khatun** and **Tamisha Khatun** turned towards me. They grabbed me forcefully, **dragged me to the drain**, and **kicked me hard on my stomach**, causing immense pain. In the process, they **snatched my clothes**, humiliating me publicly and attempting to outrage my modesty. I felt completely helpless as they continued to assault me while the others kept beating my husband. When neighbours saw what was happening and rushed to help us, the accused persons also threatened and assaulted them, attempting to stop them from rescuing us.

We immediately transported my husband to a nearby hospital. After preliminary examination, the doctors stated that he had **multiple fractures, serious back injuries, and severe head injuries** caused by being beaten with heavy iron rods.

Due to the gravity of his condition, he was referred to Siliguri Hospital, where he remains admitted for further treatment.

In view of the above, I earnestly request you to kindly register an FIR against all the above-named accused persons for criminal trespass, unlawful assembly, attempt to murder, voluntarily causing grievous hurt, physical assault, outraging the modesty of a woman, and threatening neighbours, and take strict legal action as per the law.

I am ready to provide any further information and cooperate fully with the investigation.
