Subject: FIR against Advocate Subhankar Joarder.

Sir,

I, Smt. Sibiria Toppo @ Seberia Panna, Wife of Late Bamram Panna @ Bamram Oraon, resident of Village - Bhujabani, P.O. - Bagdogra, P.S. - Bagdogra, District - Darjeeling, Pin - 734014, West Bengal, would like to submit this written complaint for your necessary action against Advocate Subhankar Joarder, resident of Bagdogra, P.O. & P.S. Bagdogra, District - Darjeeling, Pin - 734014, who has committed serious offences of cheating, criminal breach of trust, misrepresentation, and fraudulent transfer of land. The facts are stated herein:

1. That after the death of my husband, Late Bamram Panna @ Bamram Oraon, I had entrusted Advocate Subhankar Joarder with the responsibility of preparing the partitioned Khatian/mutation of our riyati agricultural land for the purpose of equal distribution among all legal heirs, acquired by law of succession from my late husband. In addition, I also asked him to hire/appoint one Amin for the measurement and demarcation of the said landed property recorded in the L.R. Plot Nos. 1202, 1204, 1205 and 1237, in the L.R. Khatian No. 249, situated within the Mouza - Uttar Bagdogra, J.L. No. 93, P.S. - Bagdogra, District - Darjeeling, Pin - 734014.
2. That I, being an old widow lady with poor eye-sight, was/is unable to verify those documents made or drafted by Advocate Subhankar Joarder, and he started charging fees (partly) to me for the same which was excessively high and excessive.
3. That further, Advocate Subhankar Joarder demanded an excessive sum of Rs. 70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand only) per person/Khatian for the partition process, amounting to approximately Rs. 04, 90, 000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Ninety Thousand only) for all seven legal heirs.
4. That when I expressed my inability to pay such a large amount, he took undue advantage of my old age, simplicity, and helpless condition, and by fraudulent misrepresentation obtained my signatures on several documents, the nature and contents of which were not disclosed to me.
5. That Advocate Subhankar Joarder demanded to make registration of part/portion of my vacant land measuring about 2.5 kathas + 2.5 kathas = 05 kathas, in his name or

positive approach from his end.
