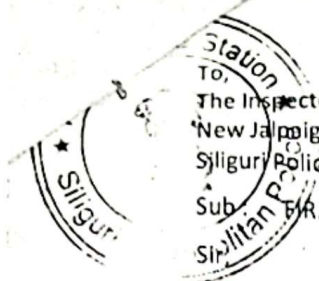

I, SI Samik Paul of New Jalpaiguri PS, Siliguri Police Commissionerate, do hereby lodge written complaint, on producing one arrested accused person named Subash Mandal (45/M) s/o Lt Tarak Mandal of Sreenagar Colony, PS New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri under arrest along with following seized articles;

1. Eleven (11) numbers bottles of Himalayan Gold 60 up country Spirit India made liquors each bottle containing 600 ml, Marked as Exhibit-A.

I am submitting a written complaint against the above noted accused person to the effect that on 21.11.2025 received a source of information that one person was selling Liquor illegally at Hospital more under PS- New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri to its customers without any valid license. Accordingly I informed the matter to the duty officer of NJP PS and I.C. NJP PS and as per his instruction myself along with, C/1462 Sajan Tamang, C/453 Uttam Dey, VP- 13 Jamirul Islam, VP- 08 Laxman Roy all of NJP PS, SPC left for Hospital more to verify the veracity of information vide NJP PS GDE No. 939 Dated- 21.11.2025. On arrival at the spot at 14.05 hrs it was found that one person mentioned above was selling liquor illegally in his shop at Hospital more to his designated customers to earn huge money for his livelihood. On seen the police party the customers as well as seller tried to flee away, but the seller was apprehended by police, on being asked he disclosed his name and address mentioned above and also confessed that he is selling Id Liquor illegally to his designated customers without any license. Thereafter in presence of witnesses I recovered the above noted articles from his possession and seized the same as per proper seizure List and labelled duly signed by him and also witnesses. On being asked the said person failed to produce any document or license for selling the liquor and confessed his guilt. As such I arrested the above noted accused person u/s 35 BNSS as It's a violation under Bengal Excise Act. The seizure & arrest was made on 21.11.25 in between 14-15 hrs. to 14-45 hrs. (Total approx 6.6 Liters).

Therefore, I request you to start a specific case under the proper section of law against one arrested person named Subash Mandal (45/M) s/o Lt Tarak Mandal of Sreenagar Colony, PS New Jalpaiguri, Dist.- Jalpaiguri and arrange for its investigation.
