Sir,

I, Akansha Roy, daughter of Late Sattya Roy, resident of Ektyashal Khudiram Pally, Near Himalayan School, P.O.- Sevoke Road, P.S.- Bhaktinagar, District- Jalpaiguri, Pin-734006, am lodging this FIR regarding the following facts:

My father, Late Sattya Roy, died in 2020. Since then, I, my mother (Namita Roy), and my grandmother (Karna Bala Roy) have been living at the above-mentioned residence. My mother works in a tile shop for our livelihood, and I am a student in class 12.

In 2021, due to financial instability, we sold a part of our residential home to Kallyan Roy.

Since the purchase of the mentioned room which is situated in front of the exit gate of our home, we and Kallyan Roy share a six-foot-wide common road. However, after a few months of purchase, the wife of Kallyan Roy, named Shilpi Roy, began throwing garbage and food waste on the common road. Despite several requests by my mother and us to stop, she continues to do so intentionally every day.

On 25/11/2025, at around 8 am, when my mother left the house to go to work, she found food particles, including fish skulls and other garbage, thrown at our gate. My mother questioned Shilpi Roy, to which Shilpi Roy replied abusively and said, "I will do more like this, do whatever you want."

After the conversation, my mother went to work. When she returned home at about 8:30 pm, Shilpi Roy again threw rotten rice and other food waste on the road. My mother again asked her why she did this repeatedly, as we use that road every day and it creates problems for us. My mother then went into our room while I was standing at the gate. Shilpi Roy came out of her room, attacked me by pulling my hair, and dragged me to the road. Hearing my screams, my aunt, Monika Singha (Barman), who was visiting

and standing on our veranda, rushed to rescue me. At that time, Kallyan Roy also joined in and started beating me and my aunt with fists and blows. When I tried to protect myself, Shilpi Roy picked up an iron rod and struck me on the head with the intent to kill. I covered my head with my hands, and as a result, the blow from the iron rod fractured the middle finger of my right hand. Hearing my cries, my mother came out of the room and rescued us.

Today, we went to Siliguri District Hospital for my treatment. I am enclosing all medical certificates with this FIR.

On 26/11/2025, between 6 pm and 6:30 pm, about 10-12 people, including men and women who were relatives of Shilpi Roy and Kallyan Roy, suddenly entered our house with wooden and Bamboo Sticks and attacked me, my mother, and my aunt mentioned above. Among them, Swapan Roy, a relative who lives at the said address, forcefully touched my breast to outrage my modesty. When my aunt tried to rescue me, Swapan Roy forcefully removed her sweatshirt and tore her kurti from the upper left hand side, with the intention of outraging her modesty. Others, including Dhanabala Roy (wife of Dhananjay Roy), Shantana Roy (daughter-in-law of Dhanabala Roy), Jharna Roy, Pratima Roy, and Bharati Roy (neighbor of Shilpi Roy), beat us by pulling hair, kicking, punching, and slapping our faces. Six to seven unidentified persons were also present, standing behind and holding wooden and bamboo sticks. After severely beating us, they left the house. Somehow, we managed to enter our room and locked ourselves inside. After one or two hours, again some male and female persons came to our yard, shouted at us to come out, and threatened to harm our lives and modesty. We did not come out of the room. I called my uncle, Sukumar Roy. When he arrived, we came out from the room and went to Siliguri District Hospital, where the doctor prescribed medicine. After that, we returned home.

Sir, in this situation, we are afraid to leave our home. Therefore, I humbly request you to kindly investigate the above-mentioned incidents, take necessary action against the accused persons, and provide us with justice.
