Dear Sir,

I, Smt Shiwani Chettri, Wife of Sri Rajendra Kumar Acharya, Daughter of Late Chandra Kumar Chettri, resident of 13th Mile, Rishi Road, Near Gangotri High School, Kaskey Gaon, Lower Echhey, PIN-734301, District- Kalimpong, West Bengal, presently residing at Universe Apartment, 2nd Floor, Block- 9, 2nd Mile, Checkpost, Post Office-Sevoke Road, Police Station- Bhaktinagar, District- Jalpaiguri, PIN-734001, West Bengal would like to lodge this complaint against my husband **Rajendra Kumar Acharya** (9832645548/9434117550), Son of Late Bhakta Prasad Acharya.

The case in a nutshell is that I was married to my husband on 06.02.2003 at my parental house at Mangal Dham, Post Office, Police Station & District- Kalimpong, PIN- 743401, West Bengal in accordance with Hindu rights and custom and our marriage was an arranged one. At the time of my marriage I was 23 years only and was already employed as a government servant in the forest department whereas my husband namely Rajendra Kumar Acharya was 9 (nine) years older to me and at the time of our marriage he was working with NHPC.

Since the inception of the marriage I was not at all happy with my husband as he was envious of me being a successful working woman and as he used to pick up unnecessary quarrel over trivial issue and to add to my woes my husband made several disparaging and condescending remarks against me and family. Be it mentioned herein that as I was working as a Government employee with the Forest Department and my job would often require me to be transferred from one place to other, my husband on several instances compelled me to quit my job and asked me to come back to Kalimpong and become a housewife. I in order to accede to my husband's unjust demand and make the marriage work even made endeavors to get myself transferred to Kalimpong so that I could stay close to my husband and was accordingly also transferred to Soil Conservation Office at Kalimpong, I was hopeful that things would now improve and normalize between me and my husband but on the contrary my husband continued to misbehave and ill-treat me. I still hoped that things would improve and

that my marriage would survive and on 06.12.2006, I was blessed with a girl child at Kalimpong Sadar Hospital and the girl child was named Rashi Acharya. With the birth of a child I was of the opinion that, my husband would be happy but all in vain as my husband expressed that he wanted a boy, this again traumatized me to such an extent that I went into depression and even contemplated of committing suicide. My health slowly improved and I was hopeful that my husband would change himself. Thereafter on 01.10.2008, I gave birth to a male child at Kalimpong Sadar Hospital named as Rishi Raj Acharya and was mindful that this time my husband would be immensely happy and satisfied but I turned out to be wrong, even after the birth of my son, my husband relentlessly abused and labelled all kinds of unfounded allegations against me, I was left all alone to fend for myself and my minor children and my husband never ever gave any support or assistance to me that a wife deserves. All this factors collectively added to the woes of the petitioner and in the year 2013, I was diagnosed with clinical depression which required immediate medical attention. I could not sleep properly and had anxiety attacks as I was all alone and had to look after my children and ensure their proper upbringing and welfare besides taking care of my job and managing bills and expenses.

In the year, 2012, I had to shift to Dowhill, Kurseong for training purpose and as a consequence thereof, I was left with no other alternative but to keep my children with my mother at Mangal Dham, Kalimpong, my husband as usual used to pick up fights and quarrels with me over phone calls almost every day as he deliberately demanded that I should quit my job and retreat back to Kalimpong but when I did not accede to his unjust demand, my husband would hurl abuses and make several derogatory remarks against me. In one instance when I was on leave for some days and decided to visit my husband who was then residing at Siliguri, as my husband saw that I was accompanied by some male colleagues who had come to drop me, seeing this my husband was completely enraged and started to abuse me in front of my colleagues and right thereafter he entered his room and started to consume alcohol and in that intoxicated state used his hands upon me thereby assaulted me.

Subsequently when my training was over, I returned back to Kalimpong. After returning back, I found out that my husband regularly used to come home late at night in an intoxicated condition and had become a habitual drunkard, the situation was such that he would become violent and uncontrollable, I would beg and implore my

husband to stop but my husband in his usual manner did not pay any heed to my requests, the sight of my husband behaving violently was so frightening that both my children were terrified. Furthermore, my husband is a womanizer who has multiple illicit relations with woman and despite having been caught red-handedly, my husband has no remorse and guilt.

Being concerned about the safety and wellbeing of my children and the toxic environment that all of us were living under, I decided to leave Kalimpong and accordingly in the year 2018, I along with my children came to Siliguri. Since then I along with my children are staying at Siliguri.

On 29.11.2025, my husband all of a sudden came to my house at Universe Apartment, 2nd Mile, Checkpost on the pretext that he wanted to accompany my son for his higher secondary examination at Pokhriabong. Today i.e. 30.11.2025 at around 03:00- 03:30 p.m. (approximately) my husband started to demand money from me, when I denied, he became extremely furious and started to abuse me with filthy words and charged at me with a ceramic stool, I somehow escaped his attack. Sir all these years, I kept silent but now I am in a dire situation having braved domestic violence at the instance of my husband for almost 2 (two) decades.

Under the aforesaid premises, I therefore request you to look into the matter and cause a thorough investigation and book the said culprit Rajendra Kumar Acharya in accordance with the appropriate provisions of criminal law so that justice is served. All this while I could not come before your good office as I was hoping and anticipating that my husband would change. I am ready and willing to provide all necessary support and cooperation to your good office as and when required.
