In producing herewith 02 (Two) arrested accused persons namely 1) Harendar Yadav (35) s/o Ganga Sagar Yadav of Majhariya PO Majhariya PS Buxar Dist Buxar Bihar 2) Abhishek Kumar Rajbhar (19) S/O Madan Rajbhor of Marwa PO Senbarsha PS Buxar Dist Buxar Bihar along with seized articles as mentioned below:

- 1) One yellow colour plastic bag (Basta) containing 19.714 Kg seems to be Ganja marked as Exhibit "A"
- 2) One multi colour Basmati rice bag (AROME) containing 9.185 Kg seems to be ganja marked as Exhibit B
- 3) One Silver colour Bolero four wheeler vehicle having registration no WB 66 S 6954 with key (without any documents) with one modified chamber inside the one basmati rice bag (AROME) containing 9.185 kg Ganja inside the chamber and one yellow colour plastic bag containing 19.714 kg of Ganja inside the back seat. The vehicle marked as Exhibit "c"
- 4) Indian Currency note 3500/-
- 5) Two mobile phone, one key pad mobile ITEL vide mobile no 7739450573 blue in colour, and one blue colour Lava Android mobile phone having M/No 9241754265.

I, SI Paresh Barman of New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC, do here by lodge this written complaint to the effect that today on 26-11-2025 at about 22:25 hrs, I received an information from my credible source that two persons is illegally carrying a huge quantity of Ganja, a controlled substance under the NDPS Act. They will expect to cross through, Murder more area under NJP P.S for its clandestine disposal and their personal gain. This information suggests a strong likelihood of a cognizable offense under the NDPS Act being committed. If not acted immediately they would succeed to smuggle the same

I reduced the information in writing vide NJP PS GDE No.1837, dated 26.11.2025 and I intimated the information to Shri Aviji Dutta, Inspector of Police, New Jalpaiguri PS, SPC, and after obtaining necessary order at about 22:40 hrs myself, along with a team consisting of I. Myself SI Paresh Barman, along with, ASI Manoj majumdar C/1462 Sajan Tamang, VP 13 Jamirul Islam, VP 08 Laxman Roy took departure from New Jalpaiguri PS for Canal Road Murder more area under NJP P.S along with laptop, portable printer, weighing machine, Drug Testing Kits and other necessary documents articles required for operation availing Govt. vehicle to work out the information and the same was diarized vide NJP P.S GDE No. 1838, dated 26.11.2025 and MCC No. 734/2025 dated: 26.11.2025.

At about 22:55, myself and raid team reached at Canal road Murder more under NJP P.S, and met my source and he briefed me about the detail information. I then looked up for public witnesses and found 02 persons namely: 1. Tarikul Md (28) s/o Md Afjal of Murder more, Paschim Dhantala PS New Jalpaiguri Dist Jalpaiguri 2. Manik Das (31) s/o Nilmoni Das of Murder more, Paschim Dhantala PS New Jalpaiguri Dist Jalpaiguri and briefed them the information in hand in a nutshell after listening to the information they both voluntarily agreed to stand as witness for the entire process of search and seizure. Thereafter, we ambushed at Canal road Murder more under NJP PS. I contacted with videographer namely Tapan Mandal and asked him to come to the spot immediately and make video graphy of whole process of search and seizure if happen.

At about 23:35 hrs, we saw one vehicle having Reg. no WB 66 S 6954 came very from Nawa para side. My source identified the person as our suspects accordingly we try to detain him but after seeing the police personals the said vehicle increased the speed of the vehicle but somehow we managed to stop the vehicle and then cordoned the vehicle and saw two persons were in the vehicle and one is driving seat and another is right side of driving seat. I introduced myself and the raid team members as Police personal showing our Govt. ID proofs, I then appraised him about the information in hand and started to examine him. During examination, they stated their names as 1) Harendar Yadav (35) s/o Ganga Sagar Yadav of Majhariya PO Majhariya PS Buxar Dist Buxar Bihar 2) Abhishek Kumar Rajbhar (19) S/O Madan Rajbhor of Marwa PO Senbarsha PS Buxar Dist Buxar Bihar. I asked them if they have any ID proof with them but they stated that now they have no ID proof with them. On further questioning, the above noted detainees made contradictory statements at different times but finally he confessed that he was in conscious possession of huge quantities of Ganja which were packed in plastic bag (Basta) concealed inside the vehicle. I then immediately as per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985, (as amended) I explained the above noted detainees and the same was given to them separately in writing stating that they have legal right to tender their personal search in front of a magistrate or a gazetted officer duly empowered under section 42 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended).

I then served Notice U/S 50 of NDPS Act to the detainee whether they were willing to be searched in presence of the police Gazetted officer or any gazetted officer of other department. In reply, he made his written consent to be searched in presence of the Police Gazetted Officer. On 27-11-2025 at 00:05 I then contact to Shri Abhijit Datta, Inspector-In Charge of New Jalpaiguri PS for his presence at PO and stand as a gazetted officer.

At about 00:30 hrs, Inspector Shri Abhijit Datta, Inspector-In Charge of New Jalpaiguri arrived on the spot and I introduced him as Gazetted officer to the detained

persons and the independent witness. I then narrated the development to him in a nutshell.

Thereafter Shri Abhijit Datta, Inspector-In Charge of New Jalpaiguri served Notice U/S 103 BNSS in writing to the above mentioned detained persons and that, if they wish, they may search every member of the searching team and the vehicles with us before the search of his person and his belongings. Then, the detainees denied to searched me and other raid team including Shri Abhijit Datta, Inspector-In Charge of New Jalpaiguri and Govt. vehicle as well as the above noted 02 public witnesses. Accordingly, I prepared a Nil seizure list, duly signed by the detainees and raid team and witnesses.

Thereafter, in presence of Shri Abhijit Datta, Inspector-In Charge of New Jalpaiguri, 02 public witnesses and the raid team, I searched the detained person and also searched their vehicle and recovered One yellow colour plastic bag from the back seat of the vehicle and also recovered one basmati rice bag (AROME) inside the chamber of the said vehicle which was modified. After open the said two bag it seems to be Ganja. After weighed the said two bag recovered 19.714 Kg seems to be Ganja from the yellow colour bag and marked as Exhibit "A" and 9.185 Kg seems to be ganja from One multi colour Bastami rice bag (AROME) and marked as Exhibit "B".

On preliminary interrogation, the above noted detainee have stated that he had brought the contraband Narcotic substance like Ganja from Cooch-behar area and was carrying to Bihar side for its clandestine disposal. I asked them to produce any valid documents for carrying and possessing of the contraband articles but they failed to produce any legal papers.

Thus, a reasonable belief having been formed that an offence has been committed in contravention of the section 8C r/w 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) and that recovered articles were liable to be confiscated U/S-60 & 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985. Accordingly, I seized all the contrabands i.e., 1) One yellow colour plastic bag(Basta) containing 19.714 Kg seems to be Ganja marked as Exhibit "A" 2) One multi colour Bastami rice bag (AROME) containing 9.185 Kg seems to be ganja marked as Exhibit B 3) One Silver colour Bolero four wheeler vehicle having registration no WB 66 S 6954 with key (with out any documents) with one modified chamber inside the one basmati rice bag (AROME) containing 9.185 kg Ganja inside the chamber and one yellow colour plastic bag containing 19.714 kg of Ganja insides the back seat. The vehicle mared as Exhibit "c" 4) Indian Currency note 3500/- 5) Two mobile phone, one key pad mobile ITEL vide mobile no 7739450573 blue in colour, and one blue colour Lava Android mobile phone having M/No 9241754265. U/S- 42 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) under proper seizure list duly prepared by me Took signature of the witnesses and the accused person, signature of Shri Abhijit Datta, Inspector-In Charge of New Jalpaiguri PS as gazetted officer and also put my signature as seizing officer. Copy of seizure list was given to the detainee.

Thereafter, all the seized articles have been properly marked and labeled. Took signature of witnesses and accused persons in the labels in presence of the Gazetted

Thereafter Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector of Police of New Jalpaiguri PS served Notice U/S 103 BNSS in writing to the above mentioned detained person and that, if he wish, he may search every member of the searching team and the vehicles with us before the search of his person and his belongings. Then, the detainee denied to searched me and other raid team including Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector of Police of New Jalpaiguri PS and Govt. vehicle as well as the above noted 02 public witnesses. Accordingly, I prepared a Nil seizure list. Duly signed by the detainees and raid team and witnesses.

Thereafter, in presence of Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector of Police of New Jalpaiguri PS, 02 public witnesses and the raid team, I searched the detained person and also searched his scooty and recovered one light pink colour plastic packet and after open the said plastic packet recovered a transparent plastic pouch containing brown colour substance said to be brown sugar carried by the detainee Gaffar Sekh. After weighed the said white color zipper plastic packet it is found 300 gms said to be brown sugar and marked as Exhibit A.

On preliminary interrogation, the above noted detainee have stated that he had brought the contraband Narcotic substance like Brown sugar from malda area and was carrying to Siliguri side for its clandestine disposal. I asked him to produce any valid documents for carrying and possessing of the contraband articles but he failed to produce any legal papers.

Thus, a reasonable belief having been formed that an offence has been committed in contravention of the section 8C r/w 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) and that recovered articles were liable to be confiscated U/S-60 & 61 of the NDPS Act, 1985. Accordingly, I seized all the contrabands i.e., 1) One transparent plastic pouch containing brown colour substance said to be brown sugar weing approx (300 grams) Three hundred grams which was kept in a light pink colour plastic carry bag which was kept concealed in the dikki of Honda Activa scooty bearing Ref. No WB 74 AC 3931 and marked as "Ex-A" 2. One Black colour Honda Activa scooty bearing Reg. No WB 74 AC 3931. 3. One Realme Android phone with Sim and battery bearing IMEI No 8603730639719151/16 in working condition. 4. Cash (RS/- 2500/-) Two thousand five hundred. 5. One DL having no WB 73 20100340737 in the name of Gaffar Sekh. 6. One original R/C in respect off Scooty no WB 74 AC/ 3931. 7. One Authorization latter in Non Judicial stamp vide stamp no 04 AC 699011 issued in the name off Gaffar Sekh valid upto 02/11/26 issued by Reg. owner Aasir Khan. 8. One SBI Bank Pass book being SBI A/C No 42269991741Slg BDN road branch U/S- 42 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) under proper seizure list duly prepared by me. Took signature of the witnesses and the accused person, signature of Shri Debabrata Sengupta, Inspector of Police of New Jalpaiguri PS as gazetted officer and also put my signature as seizing officer. Copy of seizure list was given to the detainee.
