Subject: Urgent Reminder and Report of Repeated Break-Ins and Theft at My Residence

Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I, Rajesh Gupta would like to bring to your notice about a series of break-ins and thefts occurring at the residence of Prof. Madhumita Dhar Sarkar, wife of Late Dr. Santosh Kumar Sarkar, who is a permanent resident of Prasanna Bhawan, 37, Vidyasagar Road, Khalpara, Ward No. 7, Siliguri (M. Corp), Darjeeling, West Bengal – 734005. She is presently serving as Dean, D.C. School of Legal Studies, Assam University, Silchar, Assam.

On 20/11/2025 and 21/11/2025, some miscreants unlawfully entered the residence at 37, Vidyasagar Road by breaking open all the locks. They stole two water pumps along with other household articles. They also broke the window and the lock of the tenant's godown situated on the ground floor of the premises.

She had already informed you of these incidents through an earlier email dated 24/11/2025.

However, I regret to report that such activities have continued. On 05/12/2025 at around 3:00 A.M., the miscreants once again broke into the residence and stole brass items, silver items and other gazettes, by breaking open two box beds. The CCTV footage of this incident has been attached to the email for your reference.

I further submit that the Odd End Semester Examination 2025 is presently ongoing from 13/11/2025, and as the Dean and Chairperson of the Examination Centre, it is not possible for her to avail leave or visit Siliguri frequently. Her academic and administrative responsibilities
