Subject: Complaint for registration of FIR in respect of hit-and-run road accident causing grievous hurt to my son Stephen Bagal, S/o Surajit Bagal on 07-12-2025 at Deshbandhu Para Crossing, Siliguri

Respected Sir/Madam,

I, **Surajit Bagal**, son of **Sujit Bagal**, aged about 48 years, resident of Pradhan Nagar (near Mohpal Nursing Home), Siliguri, District Darjeeling, West Bengal – 734003, do hereby lodge this written complaint for immediate registration of FIR and investigation into a serious hit-and-run road accident that took place on 07-12-2025.

A. Details of the Incident

1. On 07-12-2025 at around 6:45 PM – 7:00 PM, my son **Stephen Bagal**, son of **Surajit Bagal**, aged 23 years, was riding a scooter bearing registration number **WB-74-AC-1234** (registered in the name of his mother Mrs. Suhasini Blandina Bagal) and was going towards New Jalpaiguri Railway Station via Deshbandhu Para.
2. When he reached **Deshbandhu Para Crossing**, a Tata car (believed to be white Tata Tiago/Tiago bearing registration number **WB74AS 2257** (number noted by witnesses) came from the opposite direction at very high speed in a rash and negligent manner and collided violently with the scooter.
3. Due to the violent impact, my son **Stephen Bagal** was thrown off the scooter and sustained grievous injuries, particularly to his left leg which is completely crushed with multiple compound fractures and severe damage to bones, muscles and nerves (likely to cause permanent disability).
4. Eyewitnesses and local people forced the driver of the Tata car to take my injured son to the hospital. The driver placed **Stephen** in the same car and dropped him at the hospital gate, but **immediately thereafter fled** from the scene with the vehicle without disclosing his identity — thereby committing a clear hit-and-run offence.

B. Present Medical Condition

5. My son **Stephen Bagal**, S/o **Surajit Bagal**, is a 23-year-old graduate from Inspiria Knowledge Campus, Siliguri, and was about to begin his professional career. This accident has caused life-changing permanent injuries.

6. He was first taken to Siliguri District Hospital, but due to inadequate facilities we shifted him to Mohpal Nursing Home, Pradhan Nagar. After examination, doctors there referred him immediately to a higher centre.

7. He is presently admitted at Star Hospital, Tin Batti More, Siliguri, where the first major surgery was done yesterday on 8th December 2025 at 2:00 PM. Doctors have informed us that at least 2-3 major surgeries and prolonged treatment will be required, which is extremely expensive.

Therefore, I respectfully request you to:

Immediately register an FIR under the appropriate sections of IPC and Motor Vehicles Act. Trace, seize the offending Tata vehicle and arrest the accused driver without delay and extend all possible assistance for speedy justice and victim compensation.
