Subject: Written Complaint

Dear Sir,

I, the undersigned would like to inform you that on 29.10.2022, I had filed a suit before the Learned Civil Judge, Junior Division-I, Jalpaiguri for recovery of possession, declaration, mandatory injunction and consequential reliefs against one Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar and other defendants being Title Suit No. 490/2022 in respect of suit the property which is morefully described in schedule mentioned hereinbelow and which is presently pending for disposal before the said Learned Court.

I would like to further inform you that in connection with the said suit, I preferred a civil revision before the Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri being C.O. 101 of 2025 against and being aggrieved by order no. 24 dated 23.05.2025 as passed by the Learned Civil Judge, Junior Division-I, Jalpaiguri rejecting the application filed by me for and on behalf of all the plaintiffs under Section 151 of the Civil Procedure Code, 1908.

I would like to further inform you that Hon'ble Justice Sabyasachi Bhattacharyya, Judge, Calcutta High Court after hearing conducting counsel appearing for said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar and the conducting counsel for myself and other plaintiffs was pleased to dispose of the said Civil revision being C.O. 101 of 2025 vide his order dated 25.07.2025 with the following direction -

*"...Both parties shall maintain status quo with regard to the nature and character of the suit property till disposal of the said application. However, it is made abundantly clear that the above ad hoc order of status quo shall not in any manner prejudice the adjudication of the application for injunction by the Learned Trial Judge on its own merits and the observation made in the present order are restricted to the adjudication of*

*the present revisional application and shall not be binding on the Learned Trial Judge at any further stage of the suit or connected applications”.*

I would like to further inform you that the said application under Section 151 of C.P.C., 1908 has not yet been disposed of till date but despite the direction of the Hon'ble Justice Sabyasachi Bhattacharyya, Judge, Calcutta High Court directing both the parties for maintaining status quo with regard to the nature and character of the suit property till disposal of the said application under Section 151 of C.P.C, 1908, said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar has grossly violated the said order dated 25.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri by commercializing the said suit schedule property by taking the bookings and rents against the suit schedule property from the various interested persons for organising marriage ceremonies and reception parties in and over the suit property.

That on 28.11.2025 said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar had engaged laborers who made a pandal in and over the suit property by erecting bamboos and rope and they also accumulated a voluminous number of bamboos, carpet, curtains, iron structures, artificial flowers, fancy electrical appliances and lights and I noticed that the said laborers were hurriedly working and upon enquiry, I came to know that said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar have engaged them for using the suit property for a marriage ceremony after having taken booking in respect of the suit property from a third party including other interior works but when I requested said laborers to stop the said work as there was a status quo order, on direction of said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar, they have misbehaved with me and did not bother to stop the said work. I have already intimated you regarding the said illegal act and in the meantime, I found that the above-mentioned person has changed the nature and character of the scheduled land by flouting the injunction order of Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri, removed the iron gate which was installed for ingress and egress and taken away the same and continuously he has been exploiting the said landed property for commercial purpose and earning huge money therefrom most illegally from the various persons claiming himself as the true owner of the scheduled land.

Under the above-circumstances, I would like to request your esteemed office to take necessary steps for restraining said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar from violating the said order dated 25.07.2025 passed by Hon'ble Justice Sabyasachi Bhattacharya, Hon'ble Calcutta High Court, Circuit Bench at Jalpaiguri and ensuring that the said schedule property is not used for any purpose by said Sri Tapan Kumar Poddar @ Tapan Poddar till disposal of the application under Section 151 of CPC, 1908 by the Learned Civil Judge, Junior Division - I, at Jalpaiguri.

### SCHEDULE OF THE PROPERTY

All that piece and parcel of land measuring about 12 kathas 11 Chhatak 28 Sq. Ft. land, situated within Mouza - Dabgram, Sheet No. 7, Khatian no. 669 (C.S) corresponding to the R.S Khatian no. 314, Plot No. 421, Paragana - Baikunthapur, Ward No. 43 of Siliguri Municipal Corporation, P.S. Rajganj (Now Bhaktinagar), Dist. Jalpaiguri and a godown measuring about 10,000 Sq. Ft. by CI Sheet roofing standing thereon.
