Sir,

With due respect and humble submission I ASI Mangal Kisku of Matigara P.S. would like to lodge this written complaint against (1) Smt. Sumitra Sarkar (2) Smt. Asha Sarkar (3) Smt. Shipra Mallick (4) Smt. Anjona Mandal (5) Smt. Ruma Mandal and 20/25 others all of Patiram Jote, P.S.- Matigara, that yesterday on 09/12/2025 I was engaged with Mobile patrol duty vide C.C. No. 2642, Dated 09/12/2025 and GDE No. 444, Dated 09/12/2025 from 08:00 hrs. During said Mobile Patrol duty at about 10:30 hrs I received information that some people blocked the road at near "Bura Shib, Patiram Jote under P.S.- Matigara, Dist.- Darjeeling. Accordingly I informed the matter to I/C Matigara P.S. over phone and as per his direction I alongwith my accompanying force rushed to Patiram Jote near "Bura Shib" under P.S.- Matigara and found approx. 25/30 female persons under the leadership of above noted female persons blocked the main road from Khaprail More to Jalpaimore at Patiram Jote near "Bura Shib" under P.S.- Matigara by putting bamboo barricade in demand of immediate repairing of said road which is in a dilapidated condition. As a result huge number of vehicles, Motorcycles, pedestrians, especially vehicles carrying school students were stacked there. I requested them to clear the road as it was a beginning of office hours. But in vain, they did not care on my request. I contacted with B.D.O office, Matigara, Pradhan Matigara G.P.- II, various authorities like SJDA etc to sort out the problem and to clear the road. On my repeated request at about 14:30 hrs they moved towards Matigara Try Junction near Dry Fish Market and started road blocking again there on same demand. As it was a weekly "HAT" day at Matigara Bazar (within 50 meters) and said try junction binds road toward Tumbajote, Patiram Jote and Matigara Bazar, a huge jam of vehicles and pedestrian occurred there at once. I again informed the matter to various authorities as well as I/C Matigara P.S. Later at about 15:30 hrs after prolonged conversation by I/C Matigara P.S. as well as officials of B.D.O. office Matigara with them, road blockers went towards B.D.O. office, Matigara.

Thus the road blockers assembled unlawfully on main road on two busy places and obstructed in public way without taking any permission from any competent authority.

Under the above circumstances, I pray before you that a specific case under proper section of law may kindly started against above noted (1) Smt. Sumitra Sarkar (2) Smt. Asha Sarkar (3) Smt. Shipra Mallick (4) Smt. Anjona Mandal (5) Smt. Ruma Mandal and 20/25 others, all of Patiram Jote, P.S. Matigara and arrange for it's investigation.
