With due respect and humble submission I, PSI Surajit Das of Matigara P.S. beg to submit that myself along with force were detailed to perform Mobile Patrol duty from 22:00 hrs vide C.C. No. 2690/25, Dated 13/12/2025 and GDE No. 730. During my said mobile patrol van duty at about 08:50 hrs on 14/12/25, I got source information that Tractors, loaded with river bed material are coming towards Khaprail More from Bastu Bihar side P.S. Matigara, having no document with them. Accordingly I informed the matter to I/C Matigra P.S., over phone. After hearing the information he directed me verify the veracity of that information at once. Accordingly I along with force rushed to Panchkelguri near Alom Crasher. We found 03 (three) Tractors fitted with trolley loaded with river bed materials are coming towards Khaprail More from Bastu Bihar side. Seeing the Police team from far, Drivers/Owners of said Tractors jumped away from their Tractors keeping the Tractors in abandoned condition on the road. It may be presumed that the Drivers/Owners of said Tractors procured the loaded riverbed materials, illegally and dishonestly from elsewhere, stealing by unfair means, for their wrongful gain and proceeding to deliver the same to their designated customer. I tried hard to trace out the Drivers/Owners of said Tractors but in vain. Nobody came forward to claim the said Tractors. Finding no other alternatives I seized those Tractors with Trolley, loaded with river bed materials bearing Regn No. (i) WB74BQ5021 (ii) WB73F9177 and (iii) WB74BU6239, respectively, in presence of available witnesses, preparing proper Seizure List. I brought all the seized Tractors to Matigara PS. Search/Seizure were made in between 09:15 hrs to 09:27 hrs on 14/12/2025 under proper videography.

Therefore, I pray before your kind honour that a specific case may kindly be registered against the Drivers/Owners of Tractors fitted with Trolley bearing Regn. No. (i) WB74BQ5021 (ii) WB73F9177 and (iii) WB74BU6239, loaded with river bed materials, and arrange for it's investigation.
