Respected Sir,

I, Purusottam Agarwal, respectfully submit this letter to inform you about a theft incident that occurred at my residence located at Uttorayon, A Block, 15th Lane, House No. A-1503, under the jurisdiction of Matigara Police Station.

The incident took place on Sunday, 14th December, at approximately between 1:00 AM and 2:00 AM. Two unknown persons illegally entered our house by breaking open the window of the attached washroom of the Ground Floor Master Bedroom. After gaining entry, they roamed around the entire house.

At the time of the incident, my wife, Mrs. Rekha Agarwal, and I were present at home and sleeping in the Master Bedroom on the second floor. The intruders also entered the second-floor Master Bedroom, but upon noticing someone sleeping, they did not disturb us and quietly left the room. Thankfully, no physical harm was caused.

Although the intruders did not take any electronic items or other household valuables, the following religious idols were stolen:

1. Ganesh-Laxmi silver murti
2. Ganesh murti from the Silver Shiv Parivar set
3. Ladoo Gopal idol made of Asht Dhatu


We believe that the intruders may have mistaken the Ladoo Gopal idol to be made of gold, though it is not. However, we wish to express with deep emotional pain that the Ladoo Gopal Idol is not merely a religious item for our family. We have considered Him as a family member and have cared for Him like a child since February 2005, and His loss has caused us immense emotional distress.

We humbly request you to kindly register this complaint, conduct a thorough investigation, and take necessary action to identify the culprits and help us recover the stolen idols.

We shall extend our full cooperation and provide any assistance required during the investigation.
