Sir,

In producing herewith the 01 (one) arrested accused person namely Shakib Alam Mollah (approx), S/O- Sultan Alam Mollah of 92, Morasuli, PO- New Bhaibari, PS- Radhabala, Dist- West Garo Hills, Meghalaya, Pin- 794104 (not verified) along with the following seized article under proper seizure list :-

- (i) One transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be ganja weighing 6 Kg 64 grams and marked as 'Exhibit-A'
- (ii) One transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be ganja weighing 4 Kg 128 grams and marked as 'Exhibit-B'
- (iii) One black and red colored bag having two compartments and having logo 'NIKE' containing 'Ex-A' and marked as 'Exhibit-C'
- (iv) One blue colored bag having four compartments and having logo 'Skybags' containing 'Ex-B' and marked as 'Exhibit-D'
- (v) One gray colored Realme Narzo- 20A mobile phone having IMEI No- 869077050350998/980 bearing two sim Airtel (738860899) and Jio (9366334262).
- (vi) One Aadhaar card in the name of Shakib Alam Mollah having no- 377220755567.

I, PSI Avijit Banik of Matigara Police Station, Siliguri Police Commissionerate do hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect that on 16.12.2025 at about 19:30 hrs, received a specific information provided by a credible source that 01 (one) person is standing at a abandoned room at Paribahan Nagar, Parking area under Matigara PS with huge quantity of illegal suspected to be ganja.

Hence, there was a strong reason to believe that there is every chance of committing a cognizable offence under NDPS Act and to check the veracity of information, I reduced the information in writing vide Matigara PS GDE No, 883, Dated- 16.12.2025 and I intimated the information to Shri Arindam Bhattacharya, UC Matigara PS, SPC who brought the information to the superior and after obtaining necessary order at about 20:05 hrs myself, along with a team of Matigara PS, SPC consisting of ASI Bilash Roy, ASI Chandra Prakash Adhikari, ASI Dipak K. Chhetri, C/219 Sanatan Chitrakar all are of Matigara PS, SPC took departure vide C.C. No- 2736/25, dated- 16.12.2025 from Matigara PS, SPC for Paribahan Nagar, Parking area under Matigara PS with investigation kit by a Govt. vehicle to work out the information and the same was finalized vide Matigara PS GDE No. 885, dated- 16.12.2025.

At the same time I also informed the videographer namely Somnath Chatterjee, S/O- Sushil Chatterjee of Aurabidido Pally, Gokhal Road, W/No. 22, PS- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling over telephone to be present at Paribahan Nagar, Parking area, under Matigara PS, SPC to prepare the video of whole process of search and seizure if any. On 16.12.2025 at about 20:15 hrs, we reached at Paribahan Nagar, Parking area under Matigara PS and I met with my source and he briefed me about the detail information and show me the abandoned room where the suspected person is standing. Before that I looked up for public-witnesses to the entire process of search and seizure and found so many people from which two of them gave their willingness to act as independent witnesses. The particulars of the witnesses are as follows 1] Sikandar Chand Gupta (39 yrs approx), S/O- Suresh Gupta of Matigara Bazar, PO+ PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and 2] Sanjay Gupta (38 yrs approx), S/O- Lt. Prem Chand Gupta of Matigara Bazar, PO+ PS- Matigara, Dist- Darjeeling and I briefed them about the information we had and requested them to stand as witness, who agreed to be stand as witness during the process of search and seizure and other process thereafter. I also issue notices in writing to the witnesses. Accordingly we proceeding towards the suspected person.

In the meanwhile, I/C, Matigara PS sent a message to SDO, Siliguri to depute an Executive Magistrate during search & seizure of NDPS substances as per norms vide ORG No. 4005/25, Dated-16.12.2025. But after a telephonic conversation, it came to know that due to odd night hours and short notice, there are no Executive Magistrate available to perform the duty.

In the above circumstances and the gravity of the information, if any delay occurred, the accused person may escape. Hence, as per order of superior, I/C, Matigara PS directed Shri Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC to be present at the place of occurrence to supervise the search & seizure if any. Accordingly Shri Sajal Roy left for the place of occurrence..

At about 20:30 hrs, my source identified the suspected person who is standing at an abandoned shed at Paribahan Nagar, Parking. After a hot chase we managed to apprehend the suspected person. I disclosed my identity as police officer of Matigara Police Station and disclosed the identities of the police team accompanying me. I appraised him about the information in hand and started to examine him thoroughly. On interrogation he disclosed his name and address as mentioned above. On interrogation initially the detained person denied having any 'Ganja' with him and the bags contained other articles. But I told him that we want to search the bags carried by him. Eventually he admitted that the bags contained 'Ganja' and he procures the same from one person from Coochbehar and will sell the same to his designated customer. As per provisions of section 50 of the NDPS Act, 1985 (as amended) I explained to the above noted detained person that he has the legal right to tender his personal search and the bags carried by him in front of an Executive Magistrate or a Gazetted Officer and the same was given to him in writing. In reply he wanted to be searched in front of any one officer.

At about 21:20 hrs Shri Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC arrived at the spot as a Gazetted Officer where I briefed him the information in a nutshell. Also introduced the witnesses as noted above. Shri Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC disclosed his identity as Gazetted officer to the detained person as well as the independent witnesses and told them that he would supervise the process of search and seizure. On further interrogation, the detained person admitted in front of the Gazetted officer that he was in conscious possession of a huge quantity of 'Ganja' which was kept and concealed in the bags carrying by him.

Thereafter, in presence of the Gazetted officer, and the two independent witnesses we searched the detained person namely Shakib Alom Mollah after observing all formalities and found One gray colored Realme Narzo- 20A mobile phone having IMEI No- 869077050350998/980 bearing two sim Airtel (738860899) and Jio (9366334262) and one aadhaar card in the name of Shakib Alom Mollah having no- 377220755567 from his possession. Then the two bags were searched which were carrying by him and found the following articles:

1] The black and red colored bag having two compartments and having logo 'NIKE' containing one transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be ganja weighing 6 Kg 64 grams and 2] The blue colored bag having four compartments and having logo 'Skybags' containing One transparent plastic packet containing suspected to be ganja weighing 4 Kg 128 grams.

As directed by Shri Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC with the digital weighing machine, I had weighed both the plastic packets with its content. The plastic packet which was weighed 6 Kg 64 gram marked as 'Exhibit- A' and the plastic packet which was weighed 4 Kg 128 gram marked as 'Exhibit- B'. The black and red colored bag having two compartments and having logo 'NIKE' containing 'Ex-A' marked as 'Exhibit-C' and the blue colored bag having four compartments and having logo 'Skybags' containing 'Ex-B' marked as 'Exhibit-D'.

On asking Shakib Alom Mollah was unable to produce any documents/license in support of that 'Ganja' that was in his possession, when asked for by Shri Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC. He also admitted that he brought the suspected to be 'Ganja' from Coochbehar and waited for to deliver to his designated customer.

Thus, a reasonable belief having been formed that an offence has been committed in contravention of the NDPS Act and that recovered articles were liable to be confiscated by the NDPS Act. Accordingly, I had seized the above noted articles under proper seizure list duly prepared by me in presence of independent witnesses and Sri. Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC who acted as Gazetted officer. I also took signatures of the witnesses, and the thumb impression of the accused person and, Gazetted officer and submitted my signature as seizing officer. Copy of the seizure list was given to the detained person. I also labeled and sealed the 'Exhibit-A', and 'Exhibit-B'. Took signature of witnesses and the thumb impression of the accused person in the label in presence of the Gazette officer.

I then arrested the above noted accused person after informing him the ground of arrest for the possession and carrying of contraband 'Ganja' under the NDPS Act and issued an arrest memo to him accordingly, and took the thumb impression of the accused person and signature of witness.

The entire process of Search, seizure, Label, Seal and arrest were done in between 21:30 hrs to 22:47 hrs. The entire process of search, seizure, sealed and labeled under the supervision of Sri. Sajal Roy, Inspector of Police, Officer in Charge of NBMC OP under Matigara PS, SPC acted as Gazetted officer and video graphed of search and seizure conducted through the camera of Somnath Chatarjee, S/O-Sushil Chatarjee of Aurobindo Pally, Gokhel Road, W/No. 22, PS- Siliguri, Dist- Darjeeling in compliance with the Order of Hon'ble High Court, Kolkata.

Under the above noted fact and circumstances you are requested to kindly lodge a FIR under proper section of law and arrange for its investigation against accused person namely Shakib Alam Mollah (21 yrs approx), S/O- Sultan Alam Mollah of 92, Morasuti, PO- New Bhaithari, PS- Radhabala, Dist- West Garo Hills, Meghalaya, Pin- 794104 (not verified) and others involved in this racket.
