In producing herewith the female accused person named Smt. Bimala Lama, aged 56 years, w/o- Late Kumar Lama, resident of Station more, Railway Colony, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling (Aadhar No. 9702 9231 8973) under custody along with following seized articles under proper seizure list:

1. Eight (08) bottles of "Himalayan Gold 60° UP India Made Liquor", each contains 600 ml @ Rs. 160/-; out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit- A.
 2. Fifteen (15) bottles of "Himalayan Fata Fati 70° UP India Made Liquor", each contains 300 ml @ Rs. 50/-, out of which 01 bottle is taken out as sample and marked as Exhibit-B.
- (Total 9.3 ltrs, total value Rs. 2030/-)

I, SI Debabrata Kundu of Bagdogra PS, S.P.C, Dist- Darjeeling, do hereby lodge this written complaint against the arrested female accused person named Smt. Bimala Lama, aged 56 years, w/o- Late Kumar Lama, resident of Station more, Railway Colony, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling to the effect that on 12.12.2025 at 13:25 hrs received reliable source information that a huge quantity of liquor is stored at the house cum shop of one suspect named Smt. Bimala Lama located at Station more, Railway Colony under Bagdogra PS and the same has been selling illegally from that house cum shop for her wrongful gain. Accordingly, I informed the matter to O/C Bagdogra PS and as per direction of O/C Bagdogra PS, I along with SI Binup Mahato, LCV/1025 Anila Singha, LCV/211 Jayanti Barman, VP/01 Anselam Kujur, VP/02 Pradip Roy & CV/386 Kishor Ranjan Howladar left for Station more, Railway Colony under Bagdogra PS, SPC by Govt. vehicle No. WB61A/0137 to work out the secret source information. Under these circumstances any search warrant or authorization cannot be obtained without affording opportunity for the concealment of evidences as well as of the escape of the offender. The matter is diarised in GD vide Bagdogra PS GDE No. 530 dated 12.12.2025. At around 13:45 hrs we reached at Station more, Railway Colony and had been waited there for source indication. Thenafter, at around 13:50 hrs the source indicated us and being indication & identification by source we held raid at the house cum shop of the suspect Smt. Bimala Lama and at 13:52 hrs I managed to apprehend her with the help of accompanying lady Police personnel and interrogated her. On interrogation, she revealed her identity as Smt. Bimala Lama, aged 56 years, w/o- Late Kumar Lama, resident of Station more, Railway Colony, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling and introduced herself as the owner of that house cum shop. We disclosed our identity to her and the input we had. We searched for the independent witnesses to be present there as witness during the process of search, seizure, if any. Two independent witnesses named Sarita Bhujel, aged 54 years, w/o- Bikash Bhujel and Lalita Barman, aged 60 years, w/o- Rajen Barman, both are residents of Station more, Railway Colony, PS- Bagdogra, Dist- Darjeeling were present there to witness the process of search and seizure, if any. Then, we searched the house cum shop in presence of the independent witnesses as well as the Police personnel. On search, the above noted liquor was recovered from that house cum shop. On demand, the detainee failed to produce any valid document/license for stocking, possessing & selling that liquor from her house cum shop. She confessed that she has been stocking, possessing & selling liquor illegally from her house cum shop since long time for her wrongful gain. Her involvement is well transpired in this case. Accordingly, I seized that liquor (as noted above) from her possession under proper seizure list and at last, I arrested the involved accused Smt. Bimala Lama (as noted above) after observing all legal formalities and communicating her the ground of arrest in writing as she has committed a cognizable offence in presence of Police Officers for stocking, possessing & selling that liquor illegally and issued memo of arrest in this regard. The process of search, seizure & arrest is made in between 13:52 hrs and 14:05 hrs on 12.12.2025 through audio-video electronic means using Govt. mobile App 'WB E-Shakshya' vides Evidence Certificate No. C-530-35637-20251212143727.
