Sub: Information regarding road accident involving vehicle No. WB-74-BT-0236 resulting in accidental damage and casualty.

Sir,

I, Dhiraj Lakhota, son of Sri Pradip Lakhota, resident of, F 02 02 Uttarayon, Siliguri, would like to inform you of the following incident for your record and necessary action:

1. That I am the registered owner of the private car bearing Registration No. WB-74-BT-0236 (Toyota Innova Hycross ZXI)
2. That on the intervening night of 21.12.2025 and 22.12.2025, my brother, Sri Manish Lakhota (s/o Pradip Lakhota), who holds a valid driving license, was driving the said vehicle with my permission. He was accompanied by five other occupants: (1) Piyush Jain, (2) Shonali Dhingra, (3) Priyanka Bhansali, (4) Richa Chaudhary, and (5) Nitesh Agarwal. They were proceeding along NH-10 (Sevoke Road).
3. That at approximately 02:00 AM on 22.12.2025, while crossing the area near 7th Mile/Bengal Safari, the vehicle met with a severe accident.
4. Cause of Accident: That at the material time, the vehicle was proceeding at a moderate and safe speed of approx. 40-50 km/hr, well within the permissible limits. However, while negotiating a slight, unmarked turn near the Bengal Safari forest area, the driver encountered a sudden and dense patch of fog that severely reduced visibility to nearly zero within seconds. Due to this abrupt loss of visibility combined with the blind curve, the driver lost sight of the road margin. In a bona fide and instinctive attempt to keep the vehicle on the carriageway and ensure

passenger safety, the driver tried to maneuver the turn, but due to the slippery road surface caused by the mist/fog and the steep downward slope on the side, the vehicle unfortunately skidded off the road.

5. That due to the sudden maneuvering necessitated by the road obstruction, and the road margin being dangerously steep/sloped towards the jungle area, the vehicle skidded, the tires lost traction, and the car unfortunately disbalanced. It subsequently hit a roadside electric pole and rolled down the steep embankment into the jungle area.
6. That the sunroof of the vehicle was open, and the car turned upside down. The occupants managed to exit the vehicle through the rear window.
7. That I received a distress call around 02:20 AM and rushed to the spot. Upon arrival, we conducted a search and recovered Smt. Shonali Dhingra, who was found trapped beneath the vehicle. She was immediately rushed to Anandalok Hospital, Sevoke Road, where the attending doctors unfortunately declared her brought dead. The other occupants, including the driver, sustained various injuries and are undergoing treatment.
8. That the said accident occurred purely due to unforeseen road hazards and the difficult terrain, despite the driver's best efforts to control the vehicle. The vehicle is completely damaged (Total Loss).

I request you to kindly record this information in the General Diary for the purpose of my motor insurance claim and other legal formalities.
