Respected Sir,

I, Nirmal Chand Prasad, Son of Late Binda Prasad, resident of Venus More, Hill Cart Road, Siliguri, District Darjeeling, PIN - 734001, most respectfully submit the following for your kind consideration:

That I am a jeweller by profession and have been carrying on my business under the name and style of "B.P.S. JEWELLERS", situated at Venus More, Jadav Samitee Building, Hill Cart Road, Siliguri, District Darjeeling, PIN - 734001, having GSTIN No. 19AIPPP3132K1ZT. I have been engaged in this business since the commencement of my business journey.

That my shop is located on the ground floor, last right corner of the building. At the backside of my shop, there is a covered parking area, which is completely barricaded with iron grills and an iron shutter gate. The rear side of the building connects Venus More to Kanchanjanga Stadium Road. For additional security, I had constructed two red brick walls adjoining at the backside of my shop.

That on 27/12/2025, at about 9:30 P.M. to 10 P.M., I properly closed my shop with lock and key and all the keys of my shop all ways remain with me at night. Although my shop generally remains closed on Sundays, I usually open it for performing Puja and Aarti as per my religious rituals.

That today 28/12/2025 (Sunday), at about 10.15 A.M., my staff namely Mukesh Sahani opened the shop after taking the keys from me

and discovered that the backside wall of the shop was broken and the entire shop was vandalized. Immediately, my staff informed me, and I rushed to the shop.

Upon reaching the shop, I found that a theft had been committed. The all showcases were broken, locks of all the shelves are broken, the shop interior was completely damaged, and marks were found on the all lockers, indicating towards break them. That except the main locker where I used to keep most of the valuable gold items only, all the lockers are broken down.

I immediately informed the police authorities, and within 11 A.M police personnel arrived at the spot. They inspected the premises and recorded videos from the front to the backside of the shop. During inspection, it was found that the miscreants had entered by breaking the backside wall of the shop through the garage area by braking the iron grills and there after brake down a part of the two brick walls of back side of my shop.

The police also attempted to retrieve CCTV footage from the cameras installed inside my shop. However, all CCTV cameras were found to be damaged. Some partial footage was successfully recovered from the hard drive and its memory.

Upon verification, it was found that approximately 33 kilograms of silver and silver articles and about 155 grams of gold ornaments are missing from my shop.

I most respectfully request your authority to collect and examine CCTV footage from adjacent shops, Venus More area, and surrounding locations in order to trace and identify the offenders. I assure you of my

full cooperation with the investigating authorities in every possible manner.

At present, I am under severe mental, physical, and financial shock due to this incident. If I recall or discover any further relevant facts later, I shall communicate the same to your good office without delay.

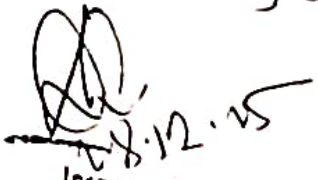
