Sir,

With due respect and humble submission, I SI. Jayanta Das of Matigara P.S do hereby lodge this written complaint to the effect that today i.e. on 29/12/2025 I was deputed to perform Mobile Patrol Van duty along with force vide Matigara P.S. C.C. No. 1802/2025, Dated 29/12/2025 and Matigara P.S. GDE No. 1545, Dated -29/12/2025 in course of said mobile patrolling duty I received a credible source information that one Tractor is coming from Balasan River loaded with River bed Materials towards Khaprail More under Matigara PS, which was procured clandestinely. On received of such information, I informed the matter to I/C Matigara PS over phone and as per his kind direction myself along with force rushed to Balasan River side and on way at Phansidewa under Pass near Jishu Ashram, P.S.- Matigara we found one Tractor fitted with Trolley, loaded with river bed materials was running in a high speed toward Khaprail More side. Somehow we managed to stop the vehicle and in the meantime the driver of the vehicle jumped out from the vehicle and fled away towards Matigara Tea Garden area. We got down from our vehicle and came close to the tractor and found the Trolley of the tractor is fully loaded with river bed materials. Registration No. of the Tractor is WB 73 G 3127. We made searched in and around of the Tea Garden to trace out the driver/owner of the vehicle but no good came out. I asked to the locals of that area but nobody could say the actual name of driver as well as owner of the said Tractor and nobody came forward to claim that Tractor. It is crystal clear that the driver/owner of the vehicle bearing Regn. No. WB 73 G 3127 procured the river bed materials from somewhere clandestinely and illegally and was preceding to sale the same to their designated customer for their wrongful gain. Finding no other alternatives, I seized the vehicle having Regn. No. WB 73 G 3127 loaded with River Bed Materials on the spot i.e. Phansidewa Under Pass near Jishu Ashram in an abandoned condition with proper seizure list followed u/s 105 of BNSS. The whole process of seizure has been videographed through WBesakshya portal. Brought the seized vehicles to Matigara P.S and kept at P.S Compound. The whole process of Seizure was made in between 20:10 hrs to 20:38 Hrs.

I therefore pray before your esteem that a specific case under proper section of Law may kindly be registered against the unknown accused driver/Owner of the seized vehicle having Regn. No. WB 73 G 3127 and arrange for its investigation.
